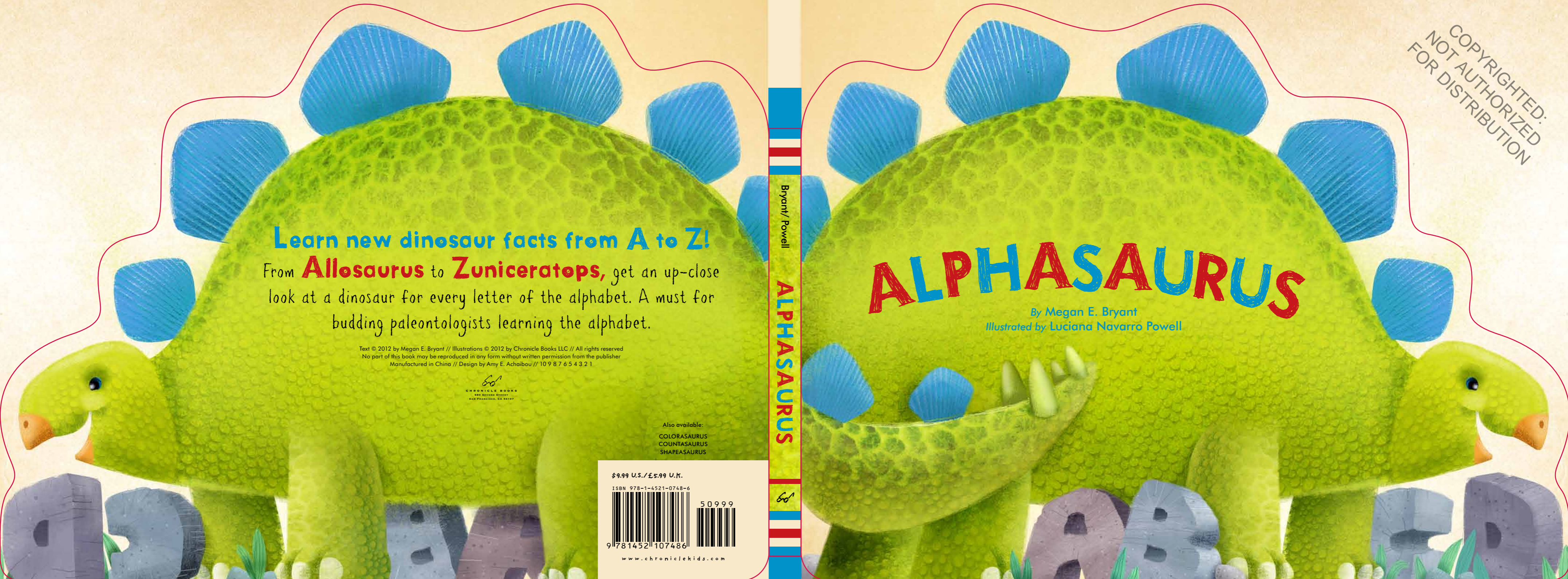

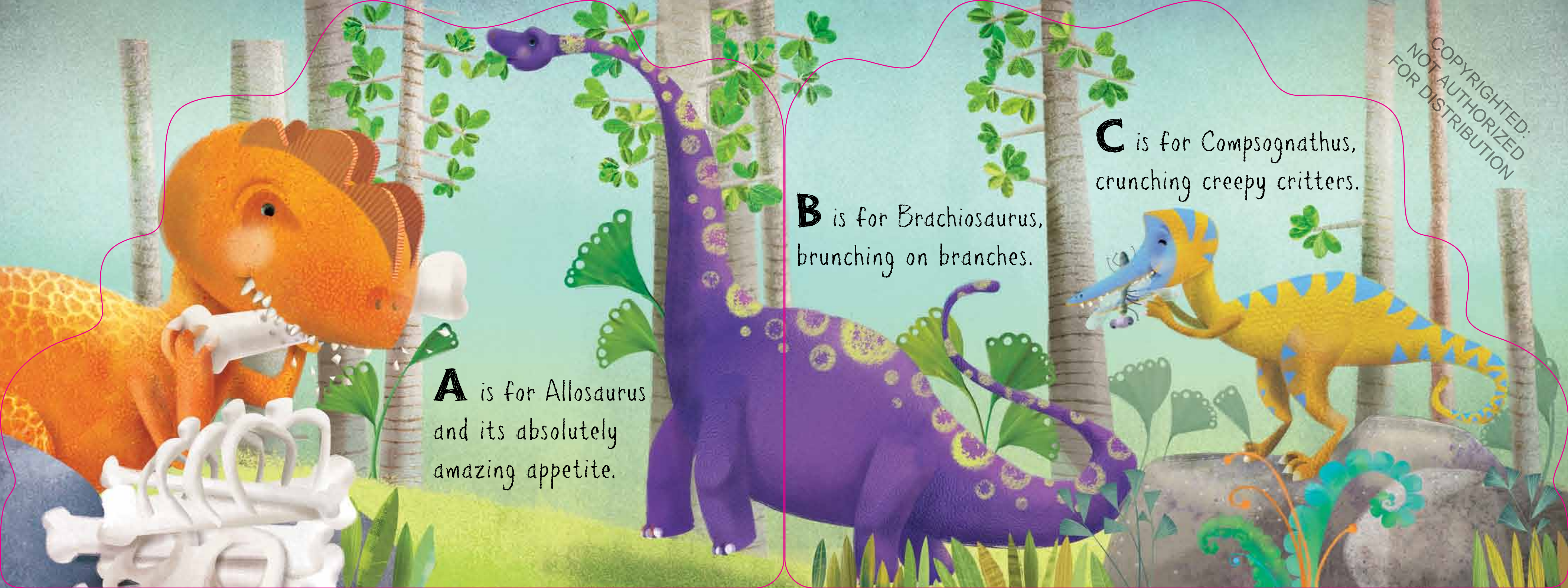

amazing appetite.

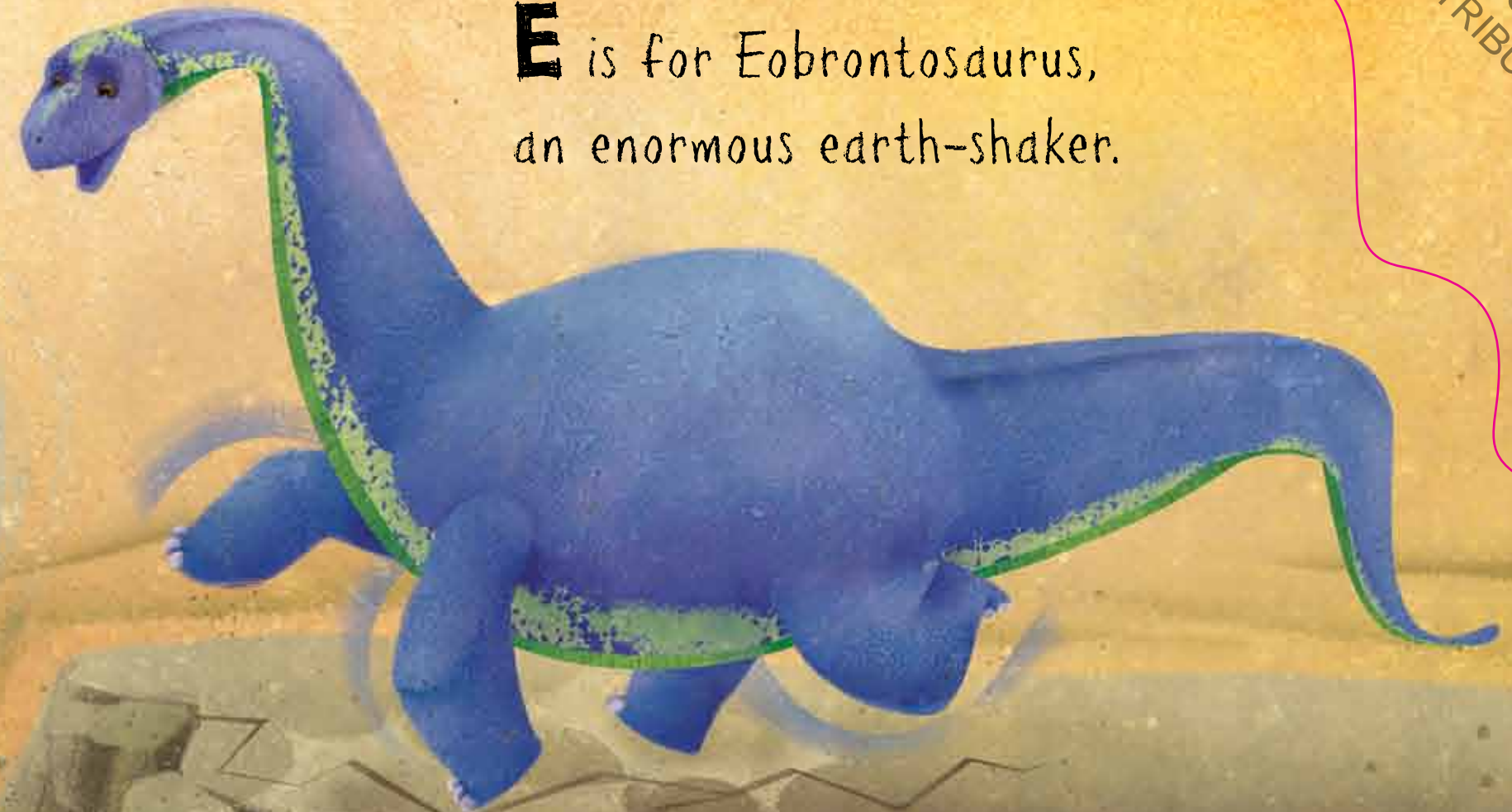
B is for Brachiosaurus,






