RECLAIMING A BLACKBERRY PATCH

Several decades before I bought the farm, Mr. Serviss's father had planted some of what were said to be the famous old Lawton blackberry plants and allowed them to develop as best they might. They recognized the business opportunity and not only "might" but did!

Nothing was apparently ever done to or for them, beyond gathering their fruit. At length, they became so choked with dead and giant stems as to be an almost impenetrable jungle. But still Mr. Serviss, following his father's example, postponed action from one year to the next, as if dreading to perform a major operation. Then he would start a new patch and, when this had begun to bear fairly well, would cut the old one, burn the debris right where it happened to fall, and finally build a straw stack upon the spot as a monument to the memory of the deceased. This treatment would so discourage the plants that they would give up the ghost—or whatever corresponds to it in blackberrydom.

So far as blackberries are concerned, this method (1) is the best I have ever heard of—if one wants to get rid of a patch. A neglected patch is nature's barbed wire entanglement. It is far more repellent than the thistle

which Scotsmen honor for having wounded the invading Danes. No other way I know of is so effective in getting the better of a runaway patch. Cutting down, plowing up, and burning alone are ineffective; the plants just laugh at such futile attempts to quell their ardor; for extermination is what they thrive upon!

Of all the untamable, obstinate, "sot-in-its-way" fruit plants with which I have ever had to deal, the blackberry is generalissimo. With rare and trivial aberrations of purpose, it has refused to part with its stiletto-like spines, and it gives no quarter to any intruder who rashly invades its domain or who attempts to prowl on its premises. The only two ways to treat it are to let somebody else be your proxy with full power to act and swear in your stead or to wear medieval armor. Even in the latter case it takes delight in discovering vulnerable spots and crevices through which to thrust, stab, grab, claw, scratch, and lacerate human flesh with fiendish delight where least expected and protected. A cat working all four legs synchronously is scarcely more efficient.

Then why, you may ask, did I retain such an unappreciative, distrustful, vindictive plant among the docile, self-respecting fruit and vegetable residents of the place?

First, because the Lawton variety, though somewhat tender to frost, bears the largest, most luscious, sweet-as-honey fruits that one could wish to have melt in his mouth. Second, because Jack Frost might presumably forget to pay the patch a visit, so the plants would have a chance to escape winter-killing and we would have fruit until our new berry bushes should come into bearing.
