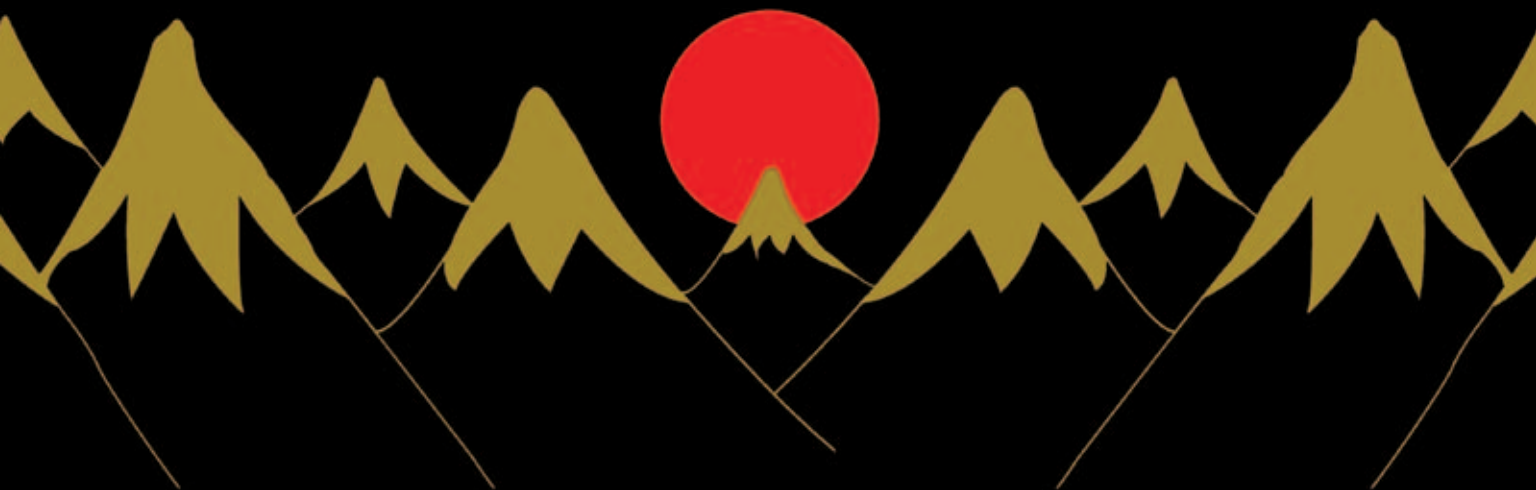

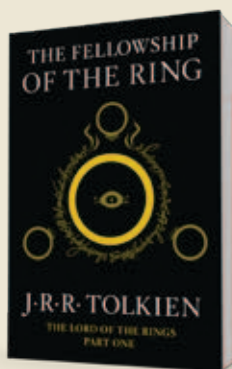

Written for J.R.R. Tolkien's own children, *The Hobbit* has sold many millions of copies worldwide.

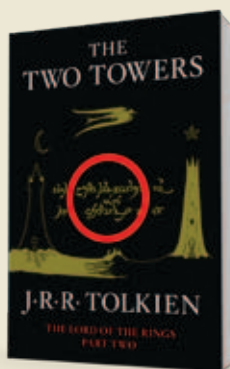

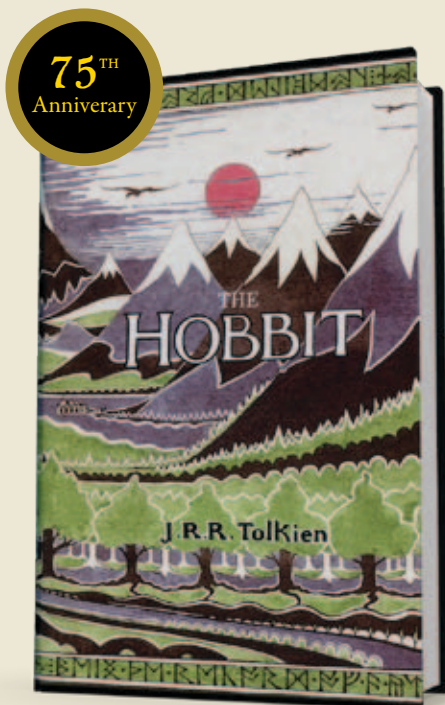

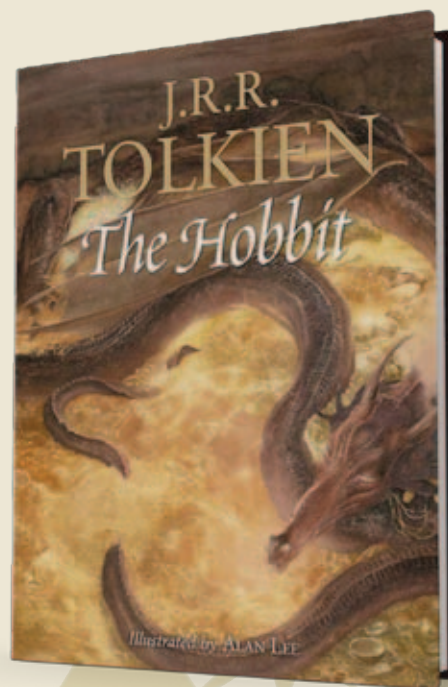
