In a spoof of "Get Rich Now!" self-help books, Willie Geist and Boyd McDonnell share the ruinous investment advice sold to them by a pair of "experts" who call themselves "The Dollar Bills," a pair of utterly unqualified, and unsuccessful, charlatans who mask their ignorance with volume, bravado, and leased cigarette boats. They spew their "wisdom" through an Internet-only radio show and a newsletter read exclusively by members of their immediate family. Alas, Geist and McDonnell were just desperate enough to buy into the Dollar Bills program.

Among other riffs, callers to the Dollar Bills' Suze Orman-style radio show ask for sensible investment strategies, only to be instructed to buy an exotic Bengal tiger or invest in a floating asset, like a pontoon boat, immediately. It's all in keeping with the Dollar Bills philosophy: In order to *be* rich, you have to *look* rich.
