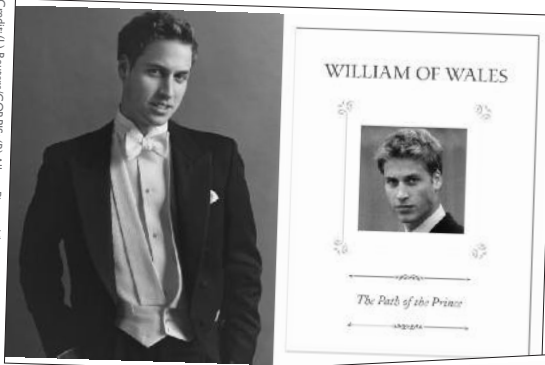

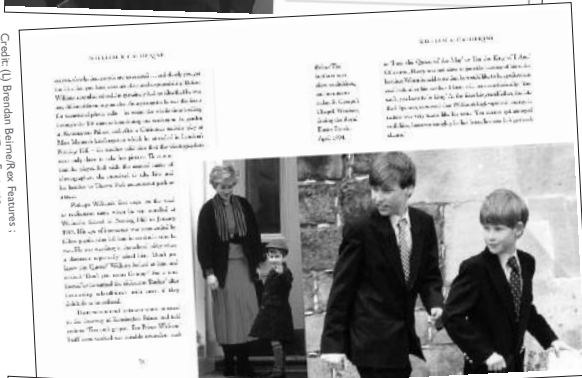

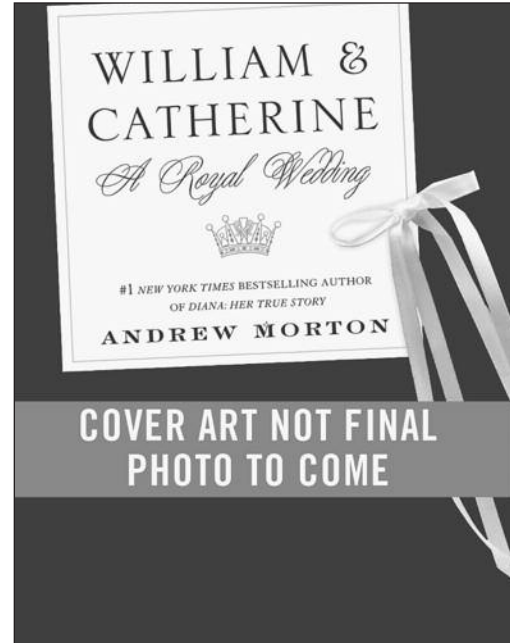

# JUST ONE CATCH

A Biography of Joseph Heller

TRACY DAUGHERTY

*In time for the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Catch-22, Tracy Daugherty, the critically acclaimed author of Hiding Man (a New Yorker and New York Times Notable Book), illuminates his most vital subject yet in this brilliant biography of Joseph Heller*

Joseph Heller was a Coney Island kid, the son of Russian immigrants, who went on to great fame and fortune. His most memorable novel took its inspiration from a mission he flew over France in WWII (his plane was filled with so much shrapnel it was a wonder it stayed in the air). Heller wrote seven novels, all of which remain in print. *Something Happened* and *Good as Gold*, to name two, are still considered the epitome of satire. His life was filled with women and romantic indiscretions, but he was perhaps more famous for his friendships—he counted Mel Brooks, Zero Mostel, Carl Reiner, Kurt Vonnegut, Norman Mailer, Mario Puzo, Dustin Hoffman, Woody Allen, and many others among his confidantes. In 1981 Heller was diagnosed with Guillain-Barré Syndrome, a debilitating syndrome that could have cost him his life. Miraculously, he recovered. When he passed away in 1999 from natural causes, he left behind a body of work that continues to sell hundreds of thousands of copies a year.

*Just One Catch* is the first biography of Yossarian's creator, with cooperation by the estate.

TRACY DAUGHERTY is the author of four novels, four short story collections, and a book of personal essays. His critically acclaimed biography of Donald Barthelme, *Hiding Man*, was published in 2009. He has received fellowships from the Guggenheim Foundation and the National Endowment for the Arts. Currently, he is Distinguished Professor of English and Creative Writing at Oregon State University.

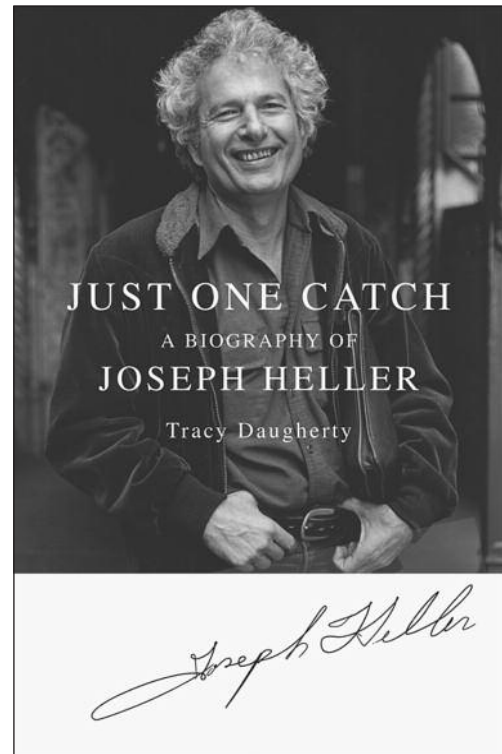

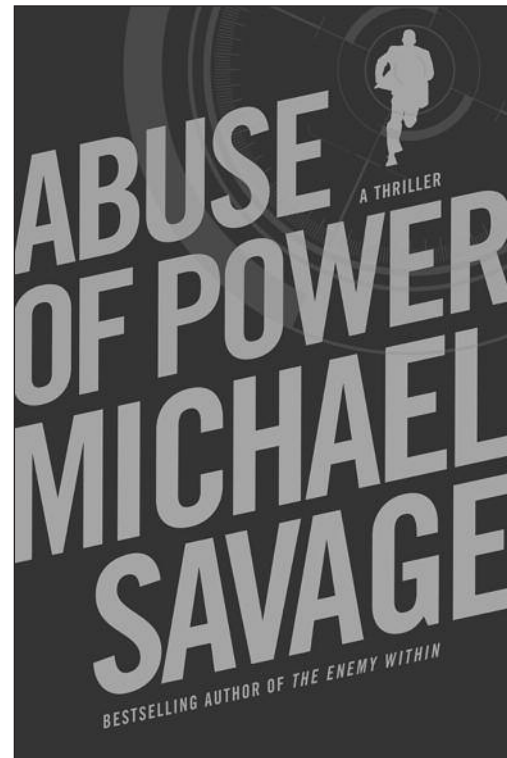

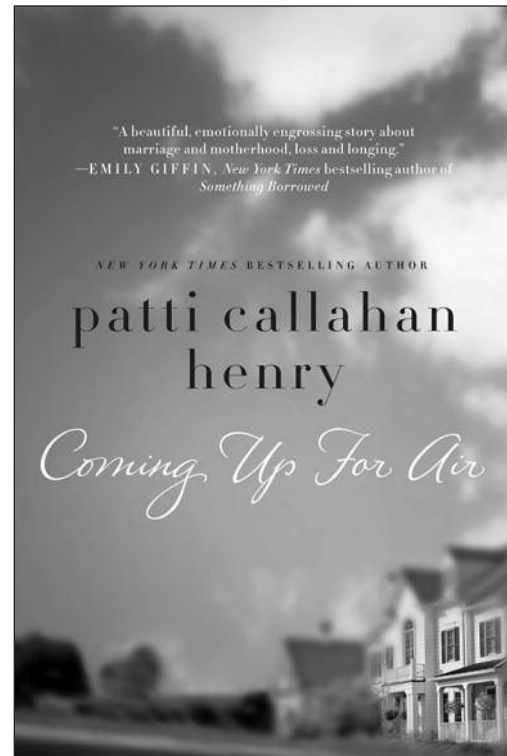

# TROUBLE MAKER

What it Takes to Make America Great Again

CHRISTINE O' DONNELL

*The 2010 candidate for Senate—and established political “troublemaker”\*—voices the quiet anger in America today: where it comes from, what it’s asking for, and where it’s going from here*

From the moment she upset a heavily-favored incumbent in the primary for the special election to fill the Delaware Senate seat vacated by Joe Biden, Christine O’Donnell made headlines. Part of this hope is invested in the nascent Tea Party, but most of it is invested in individual voters who are willing to work hard and make sacrifices for what they believe in, not what backroom dealing and a bloated federal government has mandated is good for them.

**CHRISTINE O’DONNELL** was a candidate for U.S. Senate in Delaware, most recently in 2010 for the Senate seat vacated by Joe Biden. She’s been dubbed the “Tea Party Darling,” “Troublemaker” by *Time* and a leader of the “Second American Revolution” by the foreign press. She has appeared and continues to appear on and in a wide variety of media outlets, from *Good Morning America* to *People*, *The Rush Limbaugh Show* to *Hannity* and maintains a robust national speaking schedule. *Trouble Maker* is about where O'Donnell comes from—the Philadelphia suburbs with five kids to a room—and what she weathered in the 2010 election. But the core of the book is a clear, straightforward discussion of an America that yearns to embrace freedom and opportunity through personal responsibility, and how it is hamstrung and stymied by excessive regulation, taxation, and the sanctimony of a “nanny state.” And *Trouble Maker* will deliver an important, rousing message about what we do with the quiet anger in America today: where we can go, and how strong we can be, from here. Warning readers that challenging the status quo makes the political establishment push back, O'Donnell wants to build a movement that will continue to goad it.

It's practical, too, since O'Donnell believes in power through participation: it's not enough to grumble about how things are going; pitch in and try to change things if you care. O'Donnell details how she participated by running for high office as an everywoman, but also shows how attending town council meetings, organizing a petition drive, making an effort to meet a staffer in your local representative's office, or simply reading the minutes from your community board can make a difference.

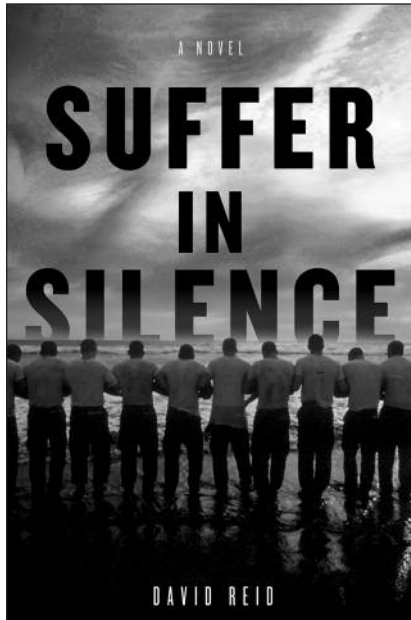

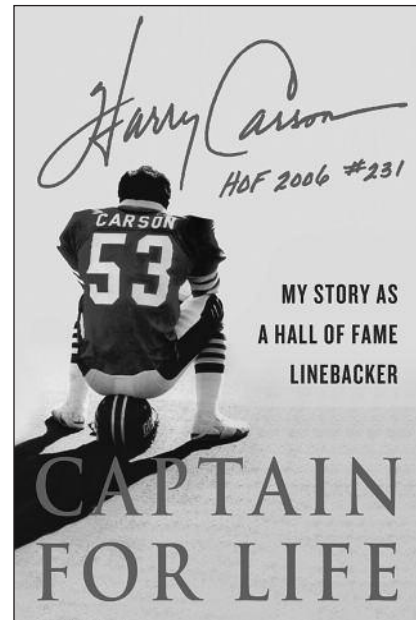

# THE LEFTOVERS

TOM PERROTTA

Through the prism of a single family, Perrotta illuminates a familiar America made strange by grief and apocalyptic anxiety. *The Leftovers* is a powerful and deeply moving book about people struggling to hold onto a belief in their own futures in the face of their greatest fears.
