

She is responsible for managing the IOM's programs, including its authoritative studies on obesity prevention. Dr. Salerno earned her M.D. and M.S. degrees from Harvard. In addition to producing HBO's The Weight of the Nation, JOHN HOFFMAN was the series producer of two-time Emmy® winner The Alzheimer's Project and the producer of the Emmy® Governors Award-winning documentary series Addiction. A vice president of HBO Documentary Films, he has spent the past fifteen years creating, producing, and supervising documentary programming for HBO.




The Mafia, Sammy "The Bull" Gravano, and Me

Karen Gravano is the daughter of Sammy "the Bull" Gravano, one of the mafia's most feared hit men. With nineteen confessed murders, the former Gambino Family underboss-and John Gotti's right-hand man-is the highest ranking gangster ever to turn State's evidence and testify against members of his high-profile crime family. But to Karen, Sammy Gravano was a sometimes elusive but always loving father figure. He was ever-present at the head of the dinner table. He made a living running a construction firm and several nightclubs. He stayed out late, and sometimes he didn't come home at all. He hosted "secret" meetings at their house, and had countless whispered conversations with "business associates." By the age of twelve, Karen knew he was a gangster. And as she grew up, while her peers worried about clothes and schoolwork, she was coming face-to-face with crime and murder. Gravano was nineteen years old when her father turned his back on the mob and cooperated with the Feds. The fabric of her family was ripped apart, and they were instantly ostracized from the communities they grew up in, living in fear of retaliation. This is the story of a daughter's struggle to reconcile the image of her loving father with that of a murdering Mafioso, and how, in the rift between the two, she was able to forge a life.

KAREN GRAVANO was born in Brooklyn, New York. She is a star of the VH1 reality TV show, *Mob Wives*, about women whose relatives are in the Mafia. She is also a producer and consultant on a film about her life. Gravano currently resides in Phoenix with her eleven-year-old daughter. LISA PULITZER is a former correspondent for *The New York Times*. She is the author or ghostwriter of more than a dozen nonfiction books in the areas of True Crime and Current Events, including a #1 New York Times bestseller on the Scott Peterson case. Pulitzer's book, *Stolen Innocence*, written with Elissa Wall, was a New York Times bestseller and sold more than 45,000 copies in its first two weeks on sale.

Alice Herz-Sommer was born in Prague in 1903. A talented pianist from a very early age, she became famous throughout Europe; but, as the Nazis rose to power, her world crumbled. In 1942, her mother was deported to the Theresienstadt concentration camp and vanished. In 1943, Alice, her husband and their six-year-old son were sent there, too. In the midst of horror, music, especially Chopin's Etudes, was Alice's salvation. Theresienstadt was a "show camp", a living slice of Nazi propaganda created to convince outsiders that the Jews were being treated humanely. In more than a hundred concerts, Alice gave her fellow prisoners hope in a time of suffering. Written with the cooperation of Alice Herz-Sommer, *Alice's Piano* is the first time her story has been told. To this day, she continues to play her piano in London and bring hope to many.

BAR NO PITTI PASTA

Bar Pitti is a well-known Italian restaurant in Manhattan's West Village where on any given night you're likely to see tables filled with movie stars and media moguls, and wait for hours to actually eat this pasta. This is my version of their fabulous pasta with peas and chorizo—and you won't have to wait to enjoy it when you make it at home.

Makes 6 servings

2 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil

1 (16-ounce) box linguini

½ cup sliced turkey chorizo


1 box frozen peas

½ cup soy milk*

2 tablespoons freshly grated Parmesan cheese Ground white pepper or red pepper flakes to taste

Bring a large pot of water to a boil and cook the linguini according to package directions. While the pasta is cooking, heat the olive oil in a large saucepan and cook the chorizo until crispy. Add the peas and cook through. Add the soy milk and Parmesan and stir until the sauce is just creamy but not goopy. Drain the linguini and add it to the sauce. Season with salt and pepper and serve.

^{*}Soy milk thickens very nicely for making sauces, but it doesn't have the vitamin D of cow's milk.
