

The boat was so enormous that elephants and tigers and turtles and dogs and every other kind of animal could fit inside. That must have been a noisy, smelly boat. After the animals and Noah and his family were in the boat, God shut the door. And then it started to rain . . . And it didn't stop for forty days! All the land and trees and mountains were covered in water. But Noah's family and the animals stayed dry and safe. Noah and his family trusted and followed God, and God saved them from the flood.





ave you ever seen a rainbow? Next time you see one, remember how much God loves you. Remember that God promises to keep you safe. Noah believed that God loved him and wanted to take care of him. Because Noah loved God, he obeyed Him, and God kept Noah and his family safe.

God does the same thing for us. He loves us and wants us to be safe, He tells us to follow and obey Him. When we follow God, He promises to watch out for us and save us from danger. He loves to take care of us!


Dear Jesus, thank You for keeping me safe. I know You love me and watch out for me.


The boy must have been excited to see Jesus. But he probably wondered how his little lunch was going to help this huge crowd.
