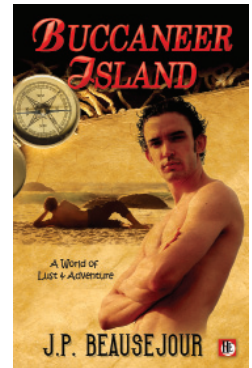
When truth is buried so deep it can kill, will the love of one woman be enough to save the life of another?

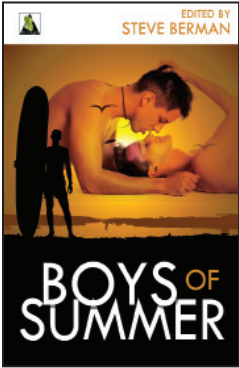


The Fling by Rebekah Weatherspoon
