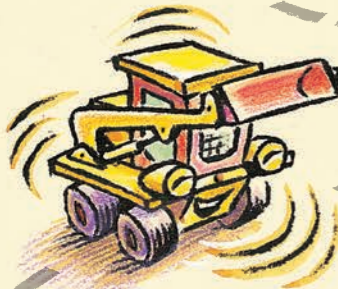
Skid Steer's nimble,

she spins—

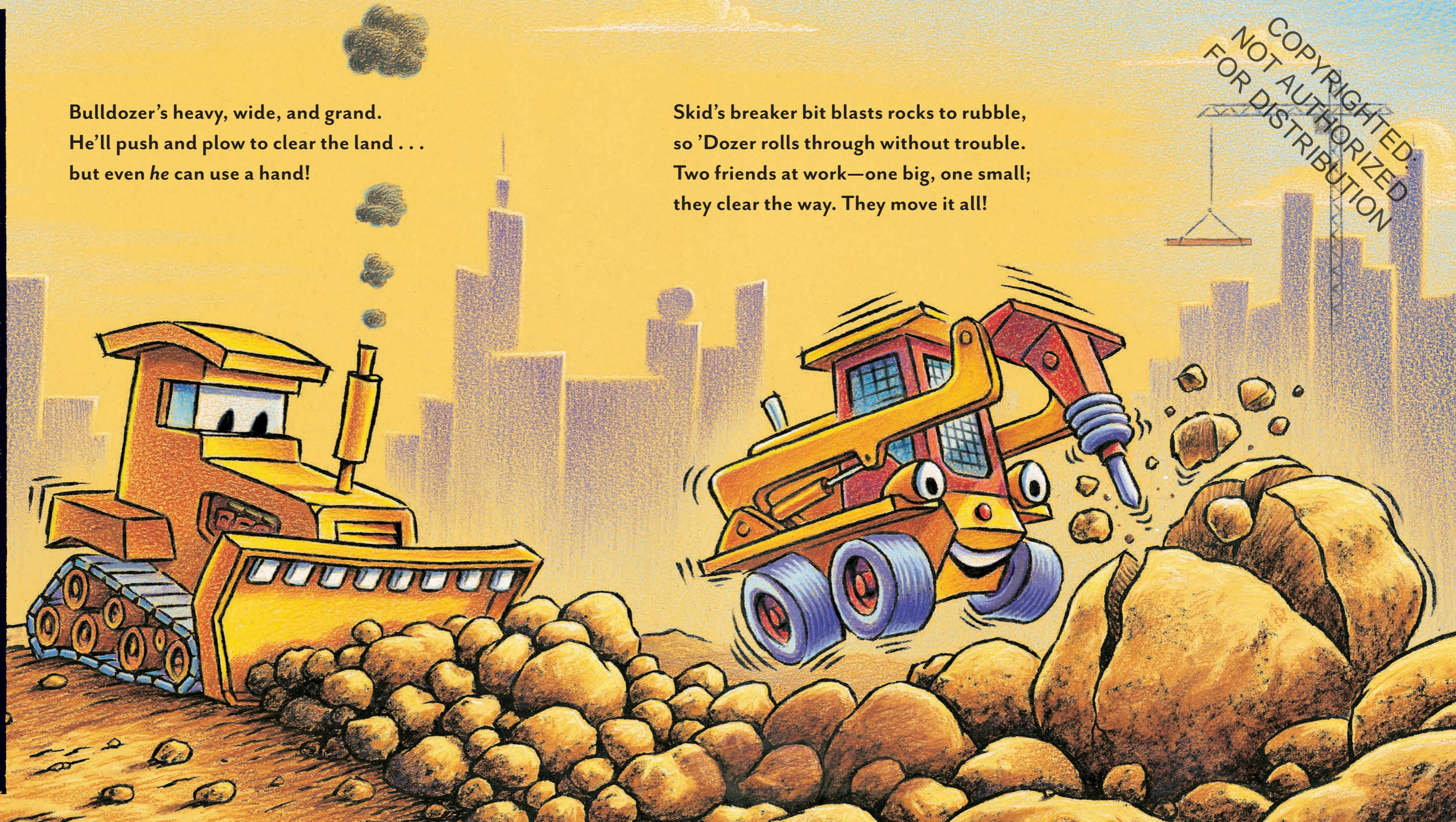


she does a trick!



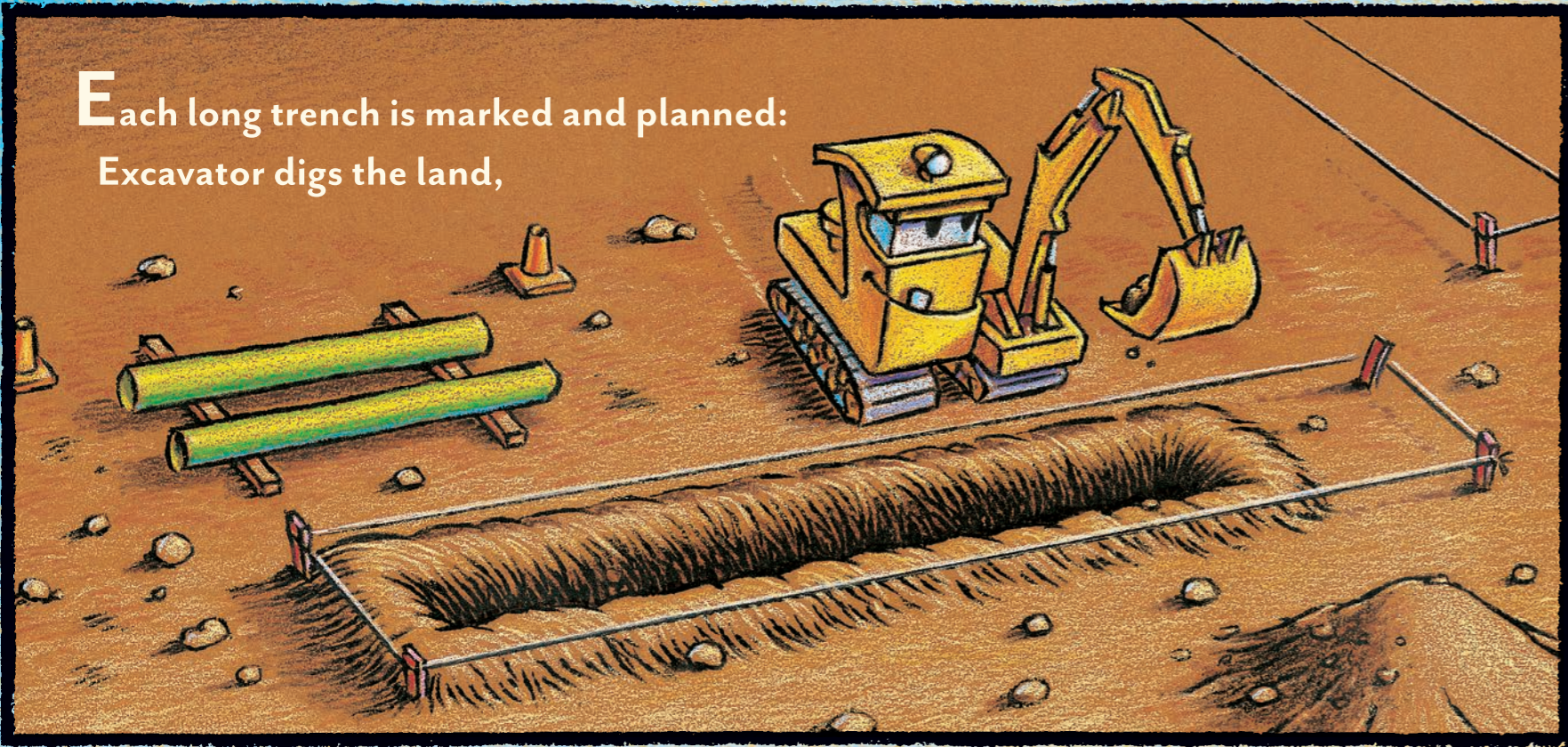
Bulldozer's heavy, wide, and grand.

they clear the way. They move it all!

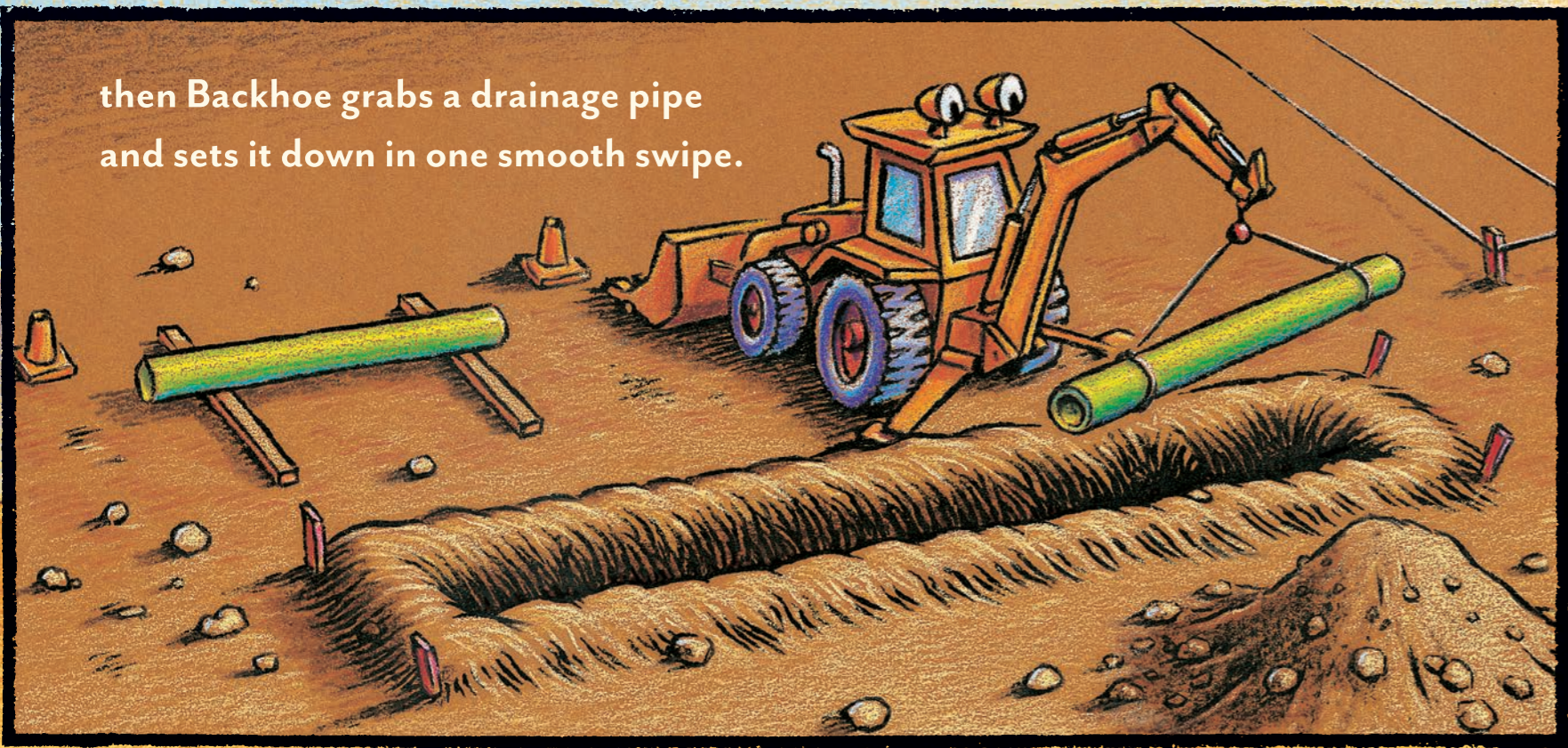

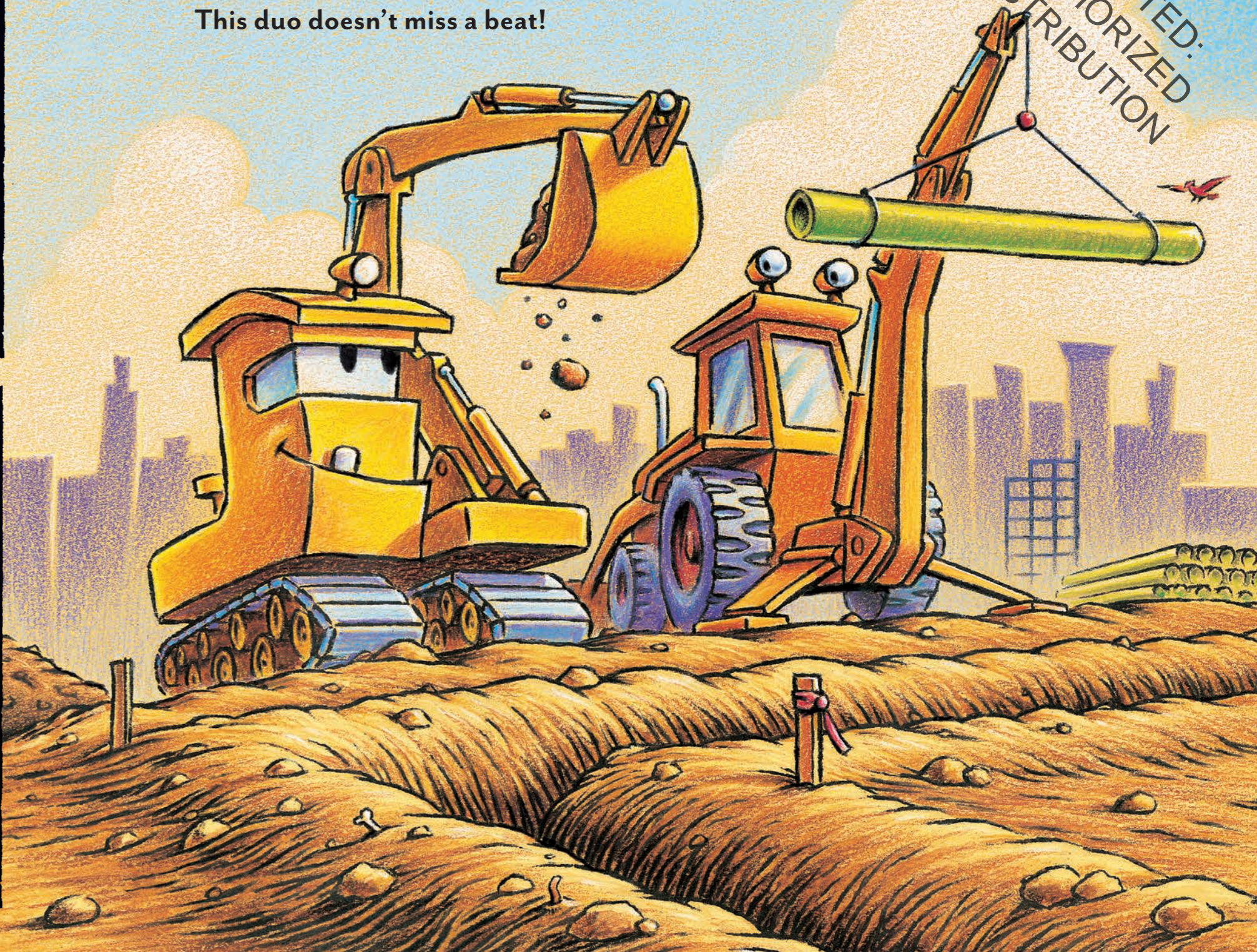
Each long trench is marked and planned:

and sets it down in one smooth swipe.



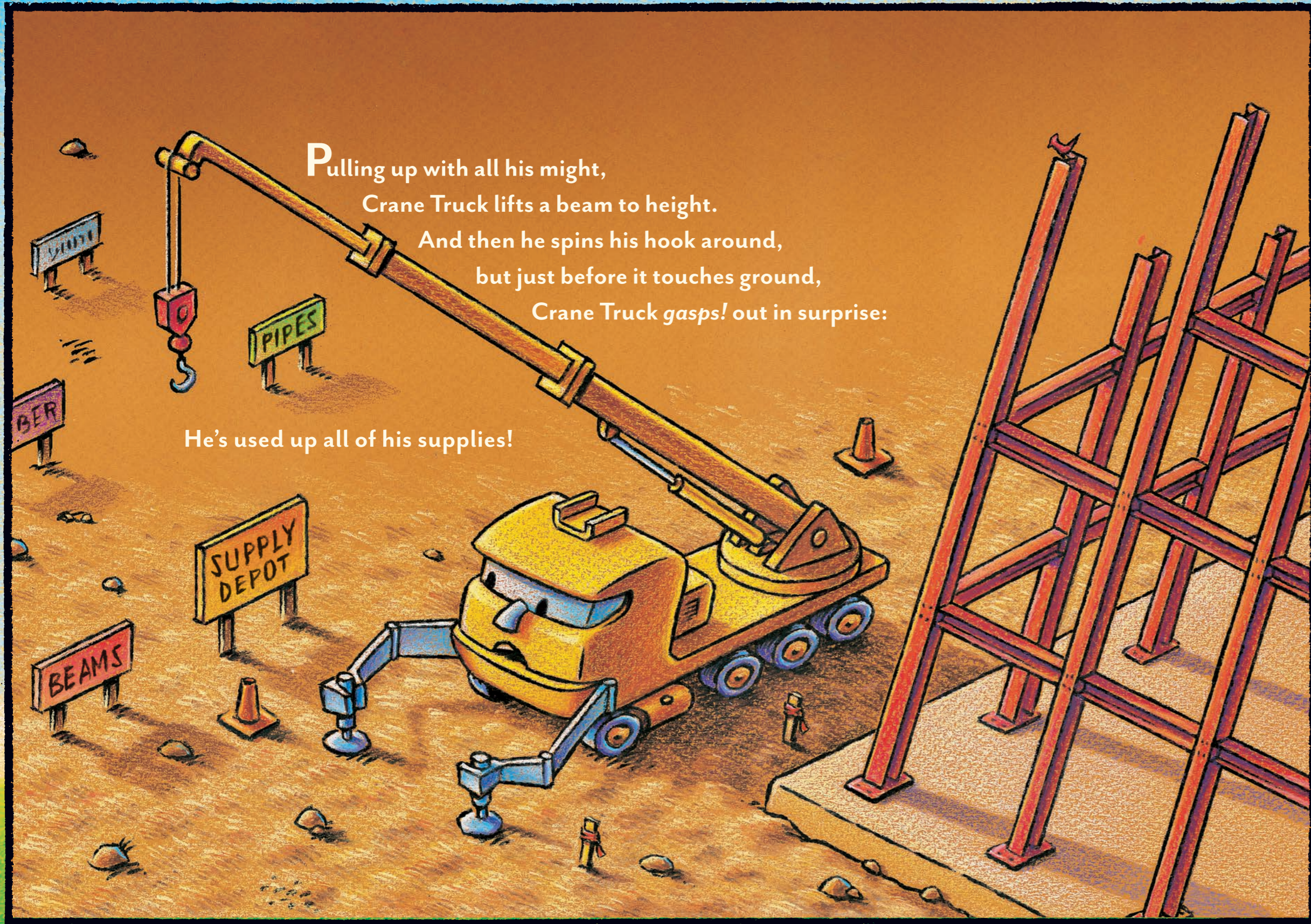
Turn and dig then lift and drop,

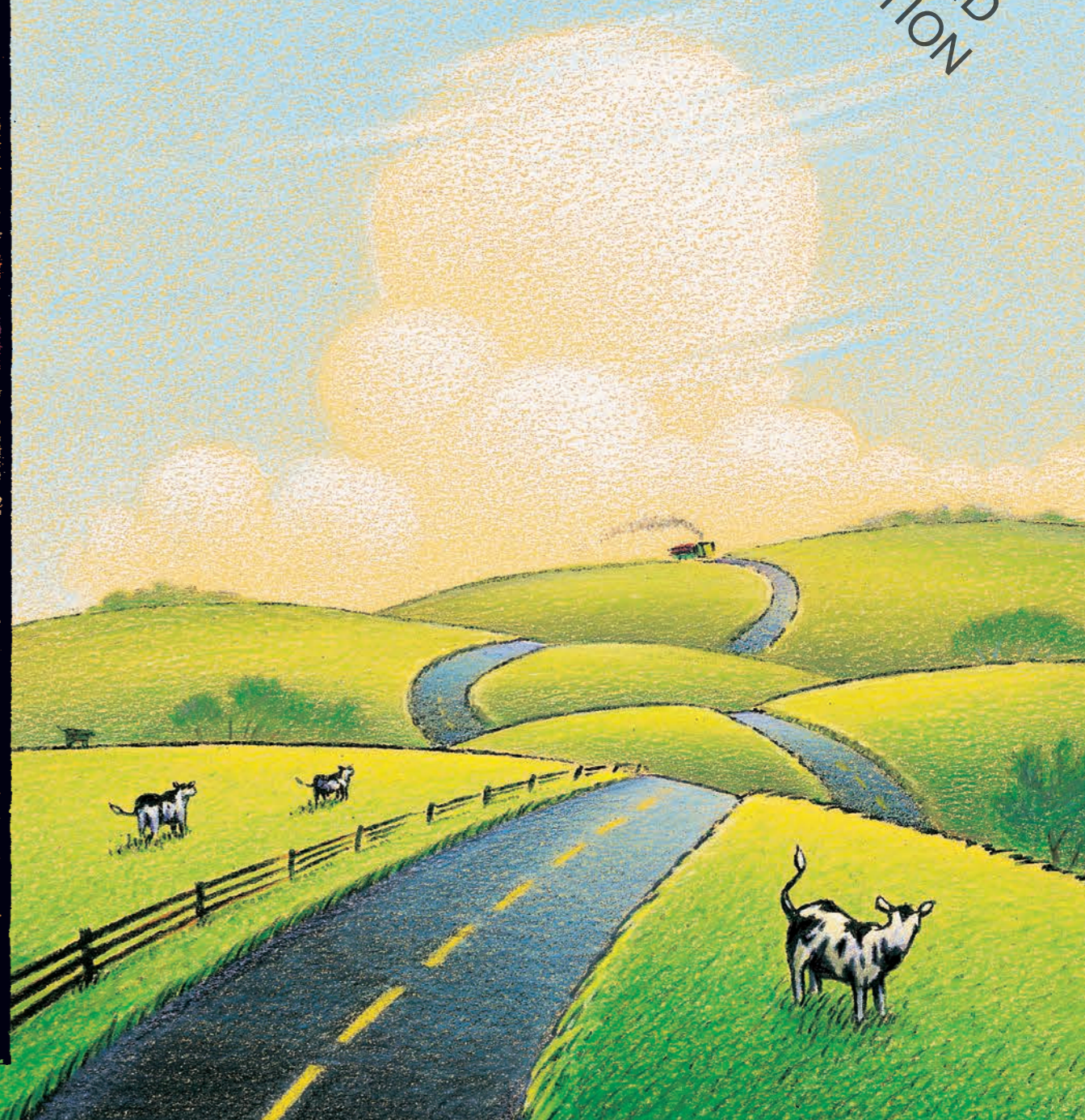
Pulling up with all his might,

Crane Truck *gasps!* out in surprise:

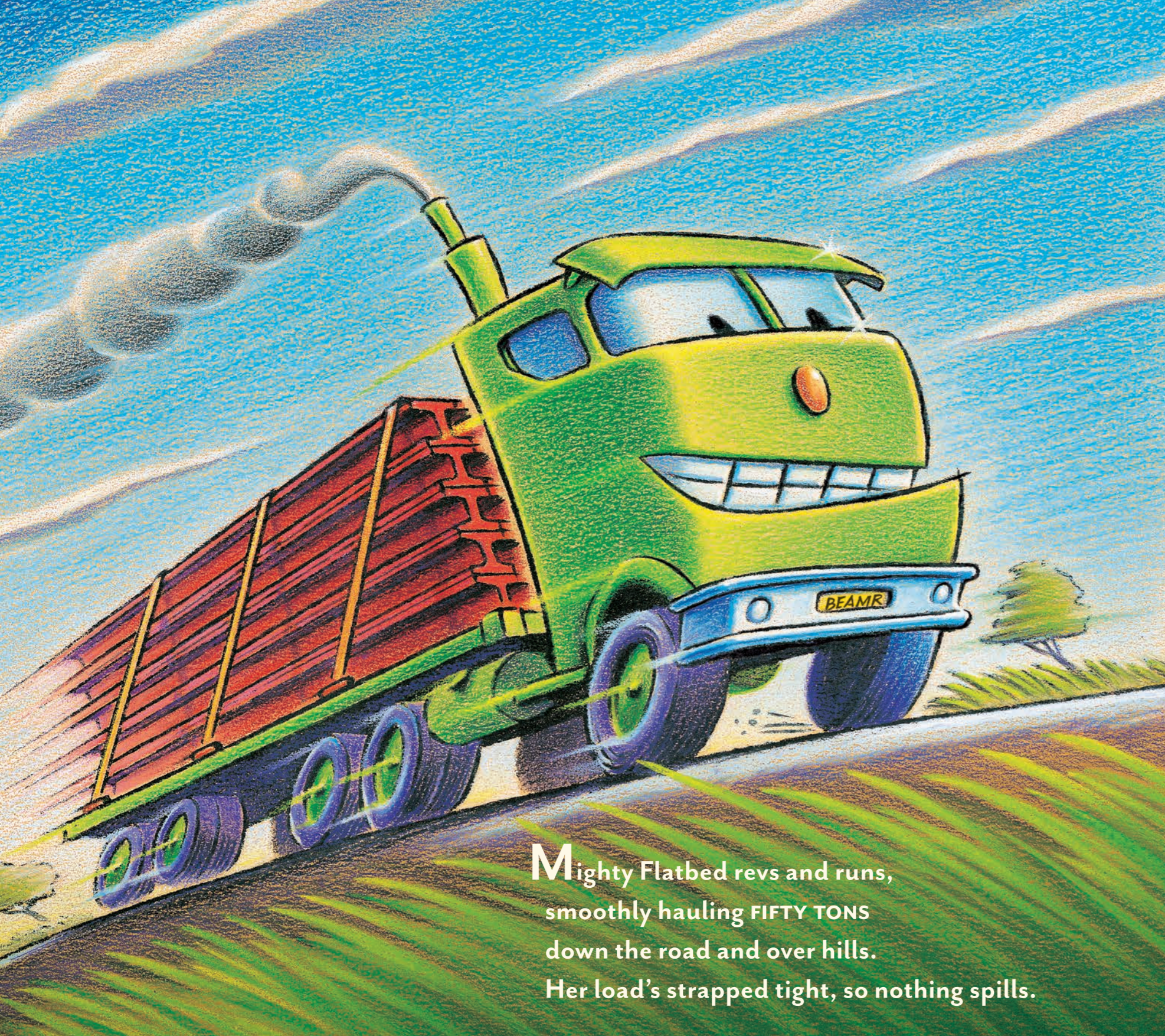
He's used up all of his supplies!

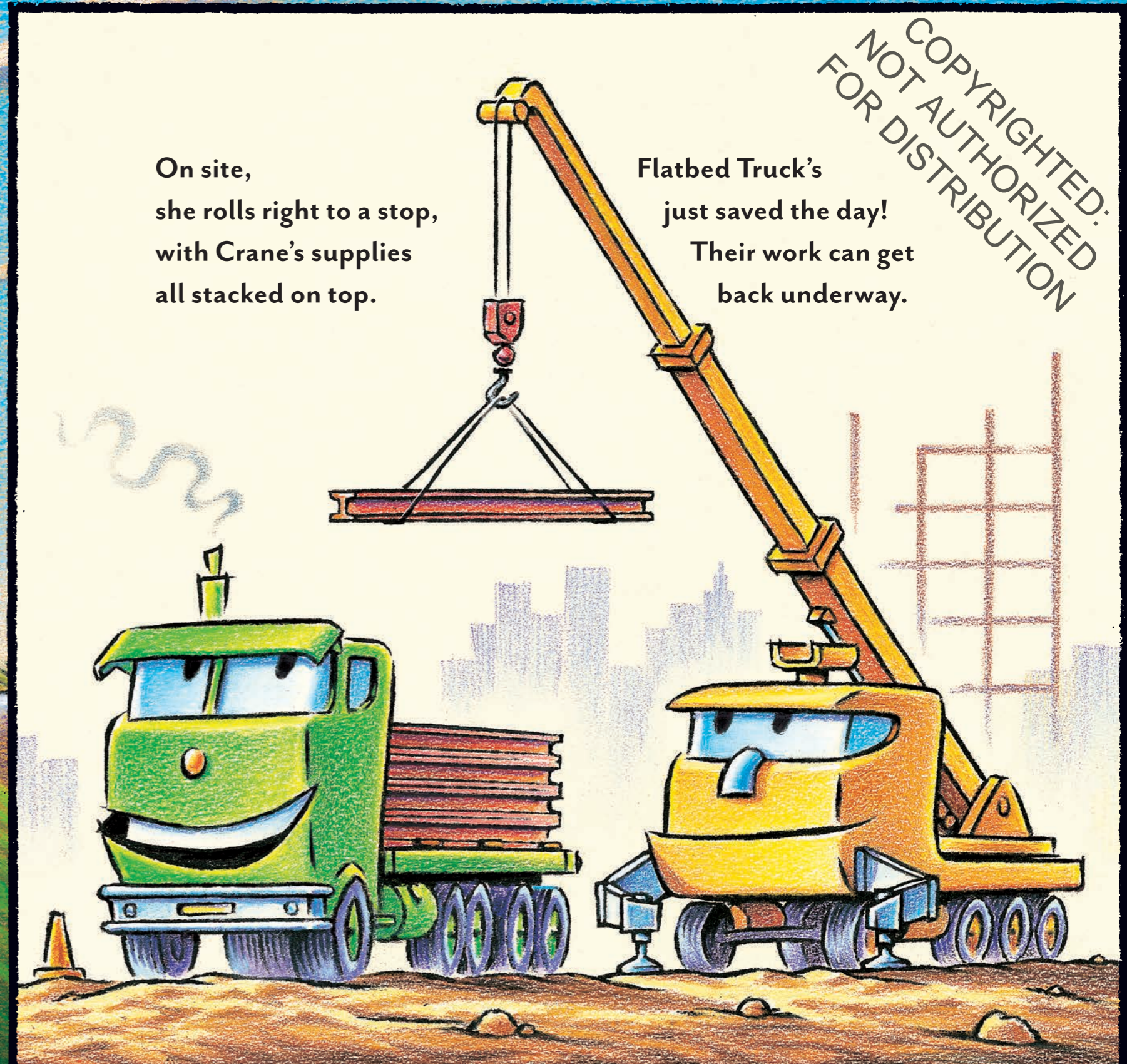




Mighty Flatbed revs and runs,

Her load's strapped tight, so nothing spills.

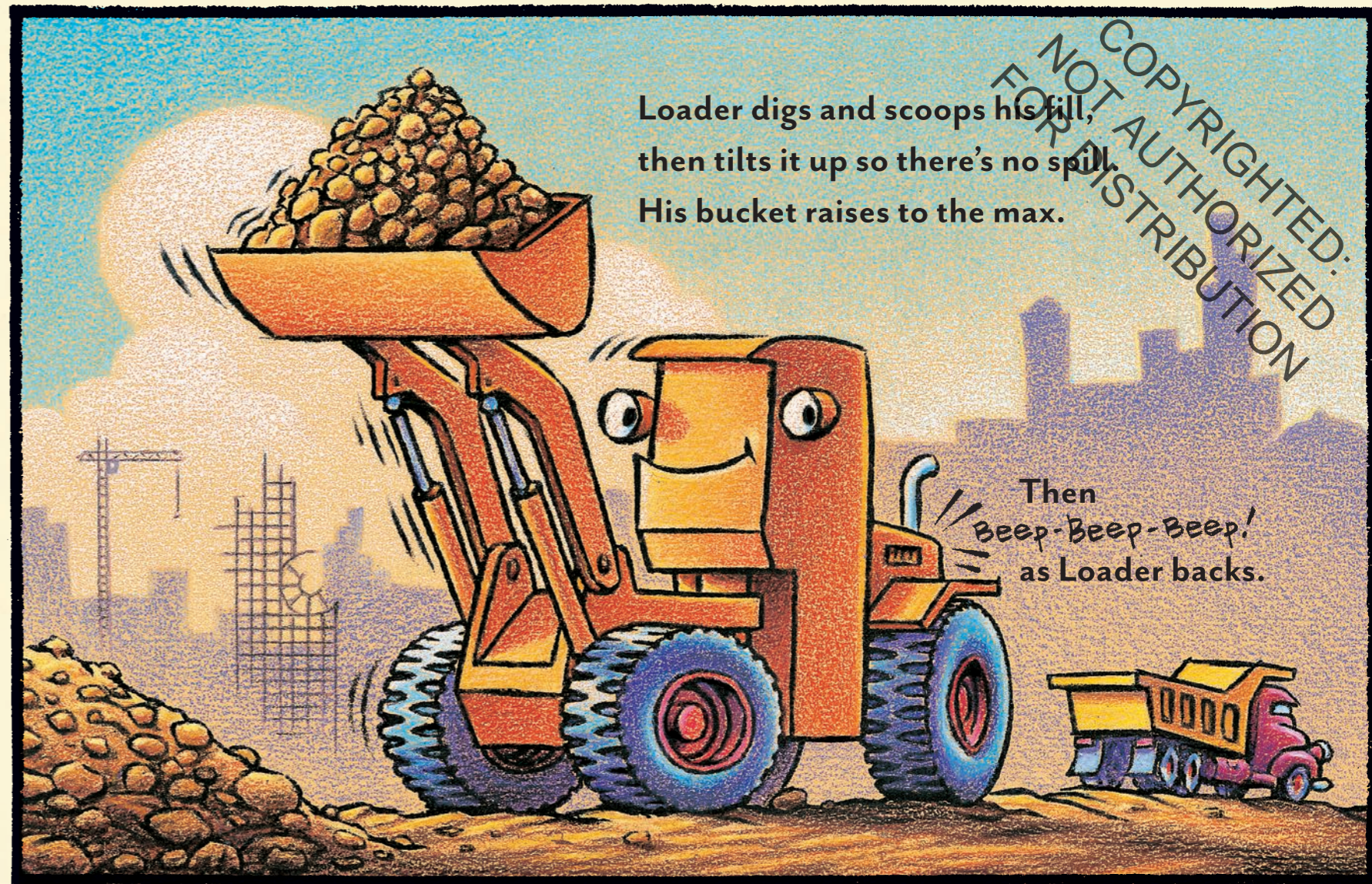
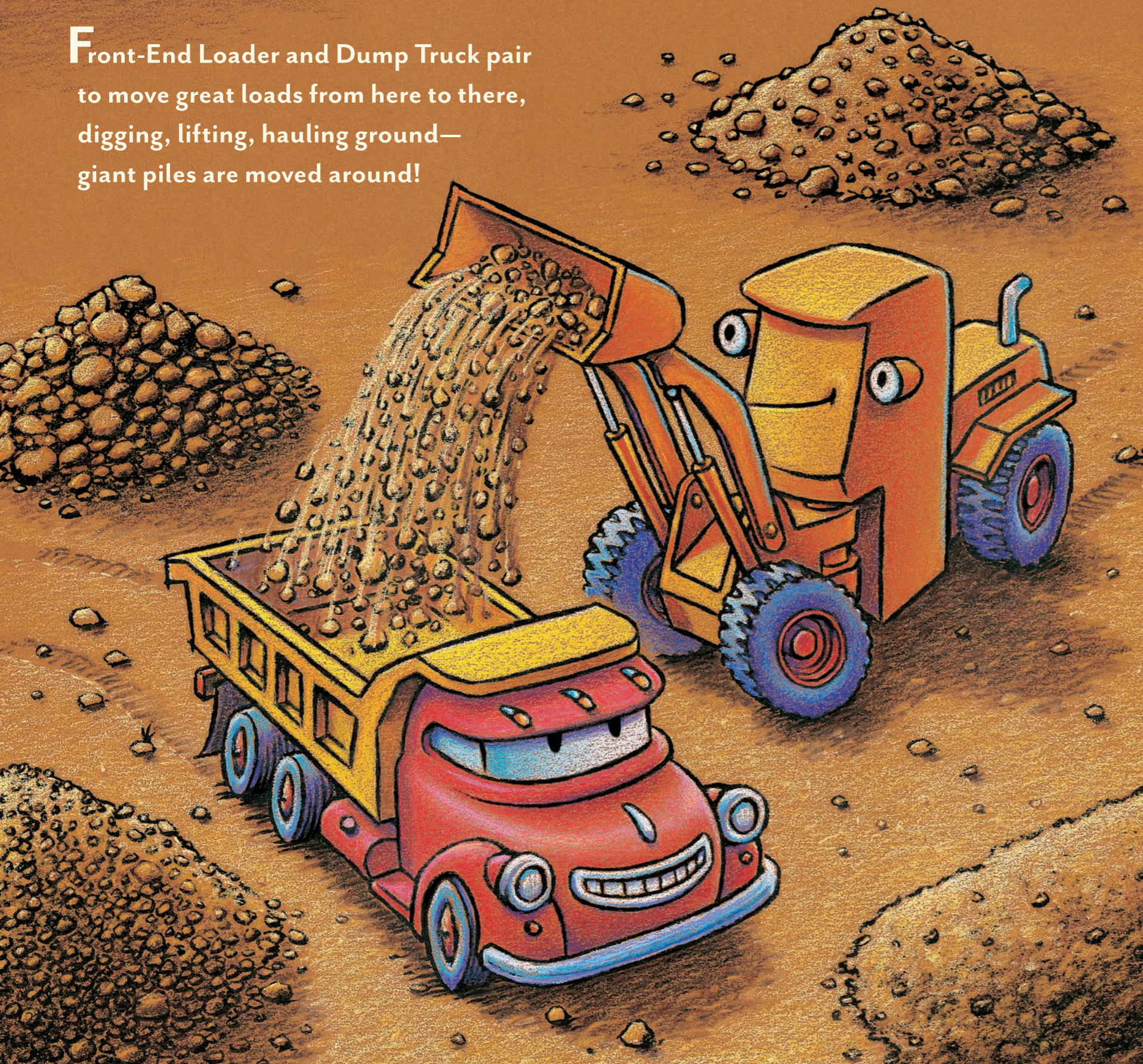

Front-End Loader and Dump Truck pair to move great loads from here to there, digging, lifting, hauling ground—giant piles are moved around!

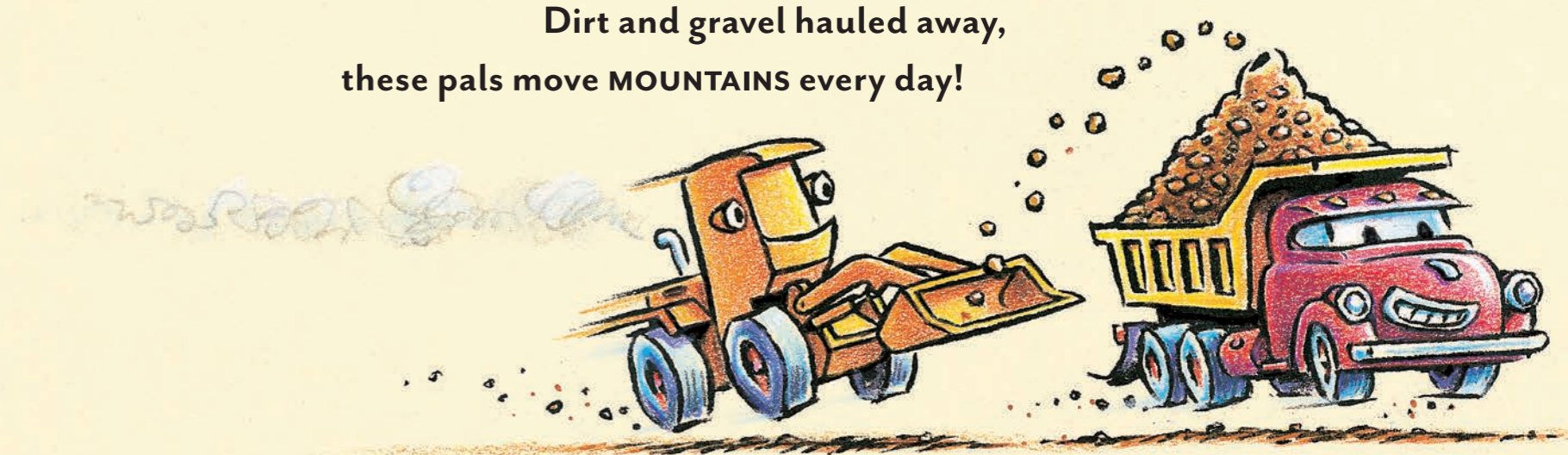


Loader digs and scoops his fill,

as Loader backs.

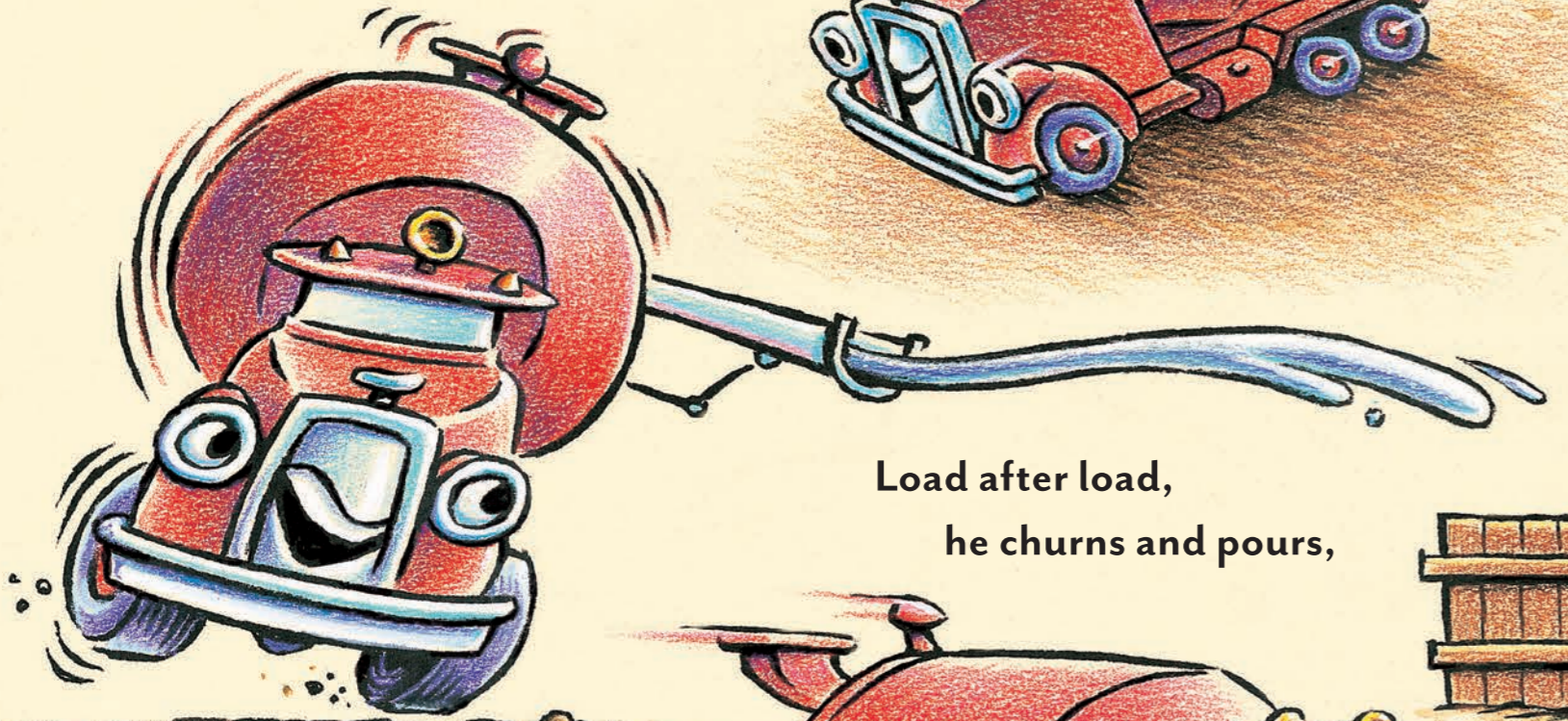

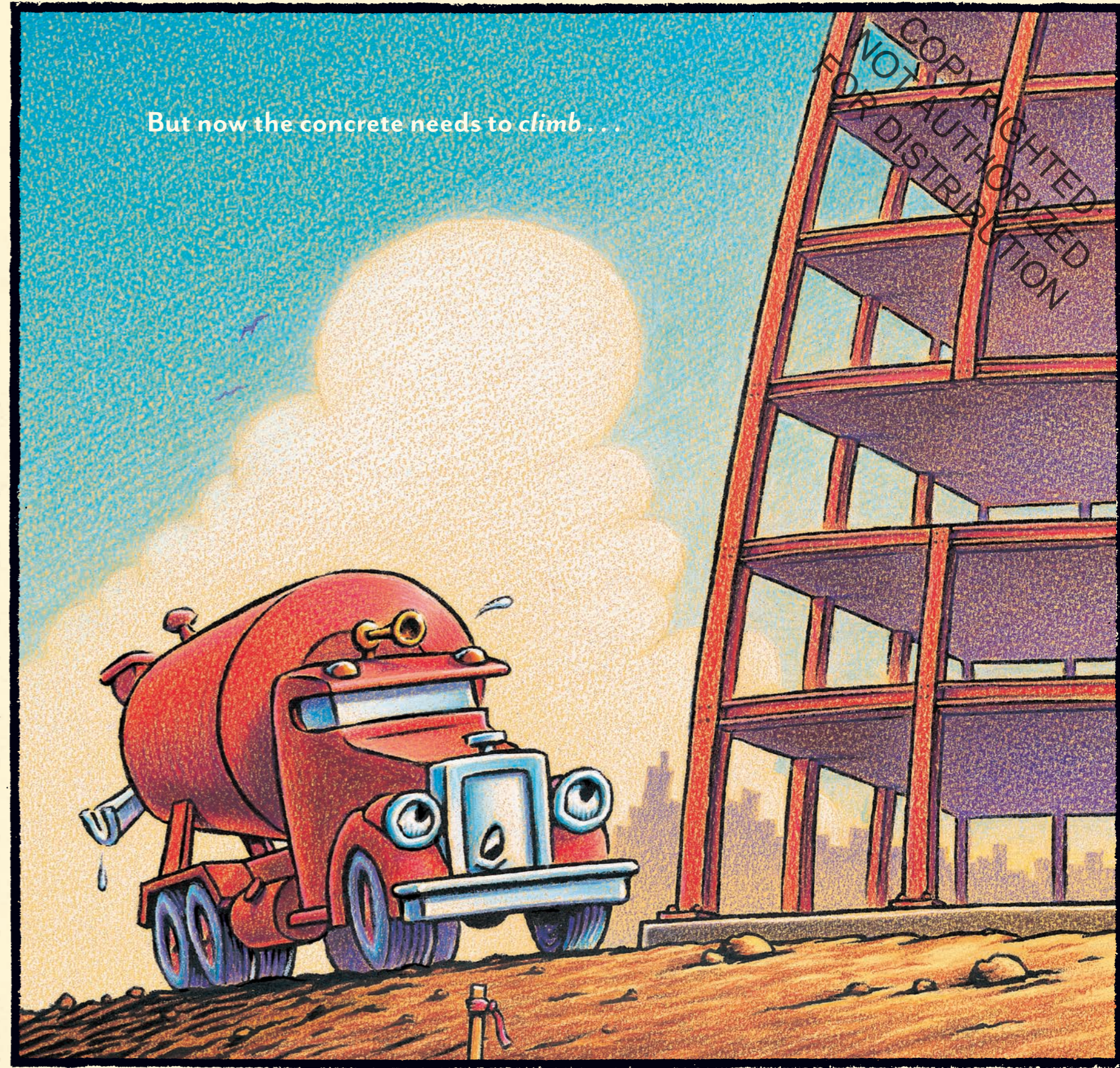
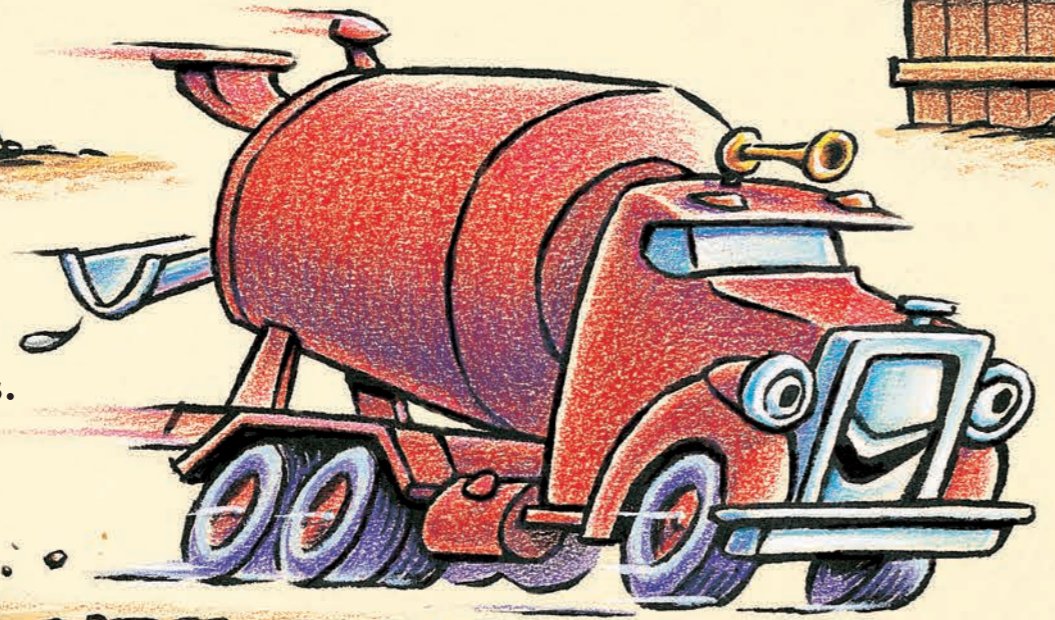
Cement Mixer is working hard around the whole construction yard.

Concrete is pushed into the boom,

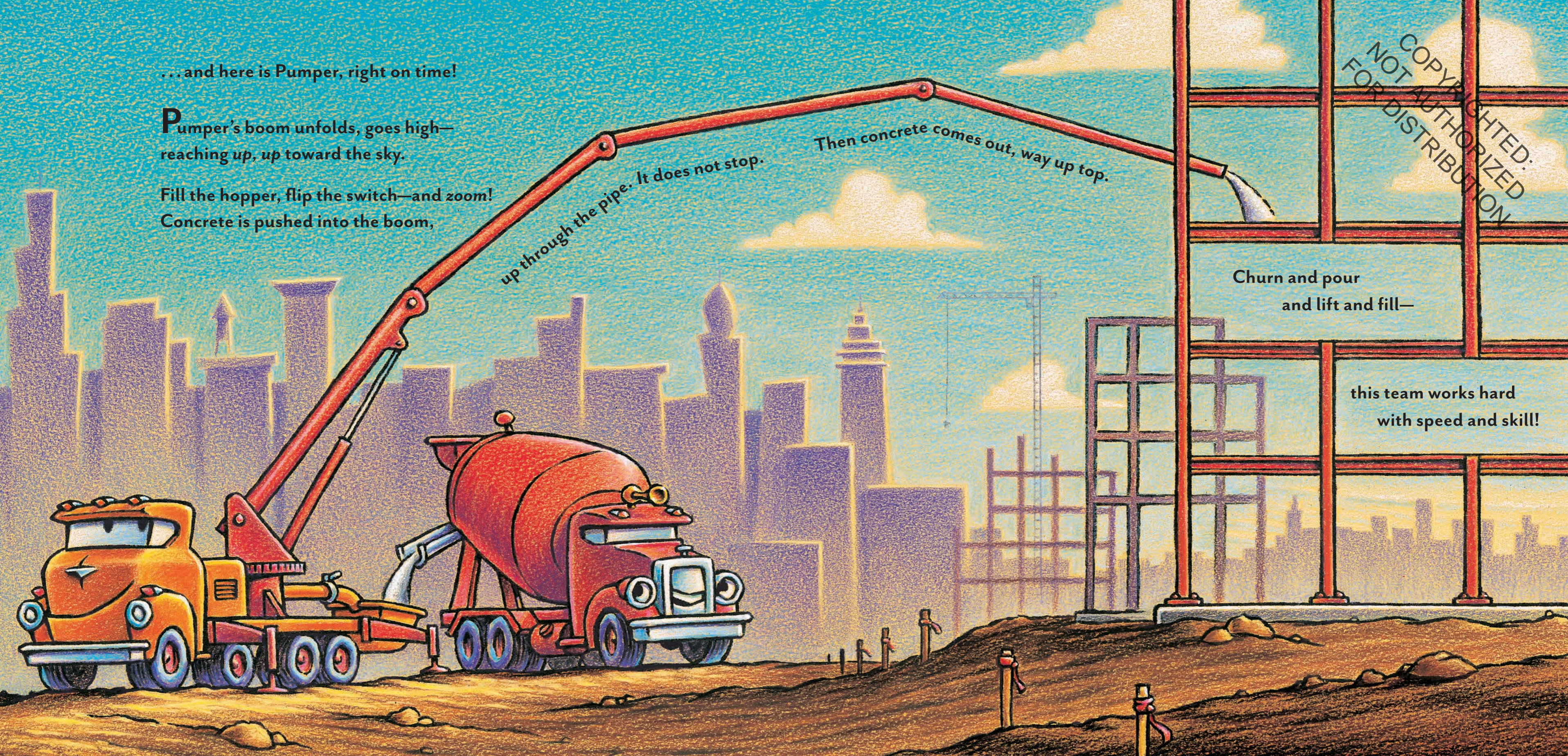
up through the pipe. It does not stop.

Then concrete comes out, way up top.

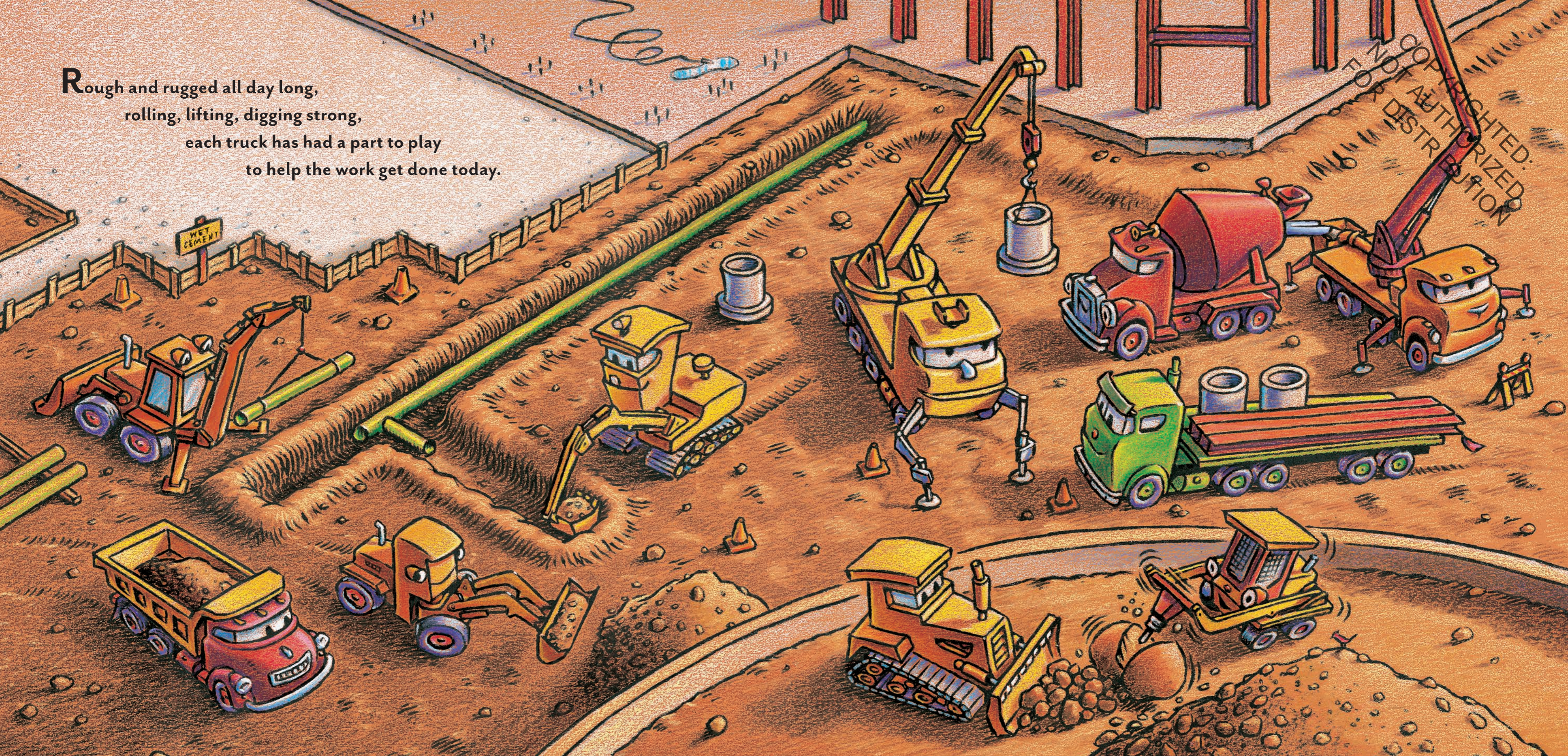
Churn and pour

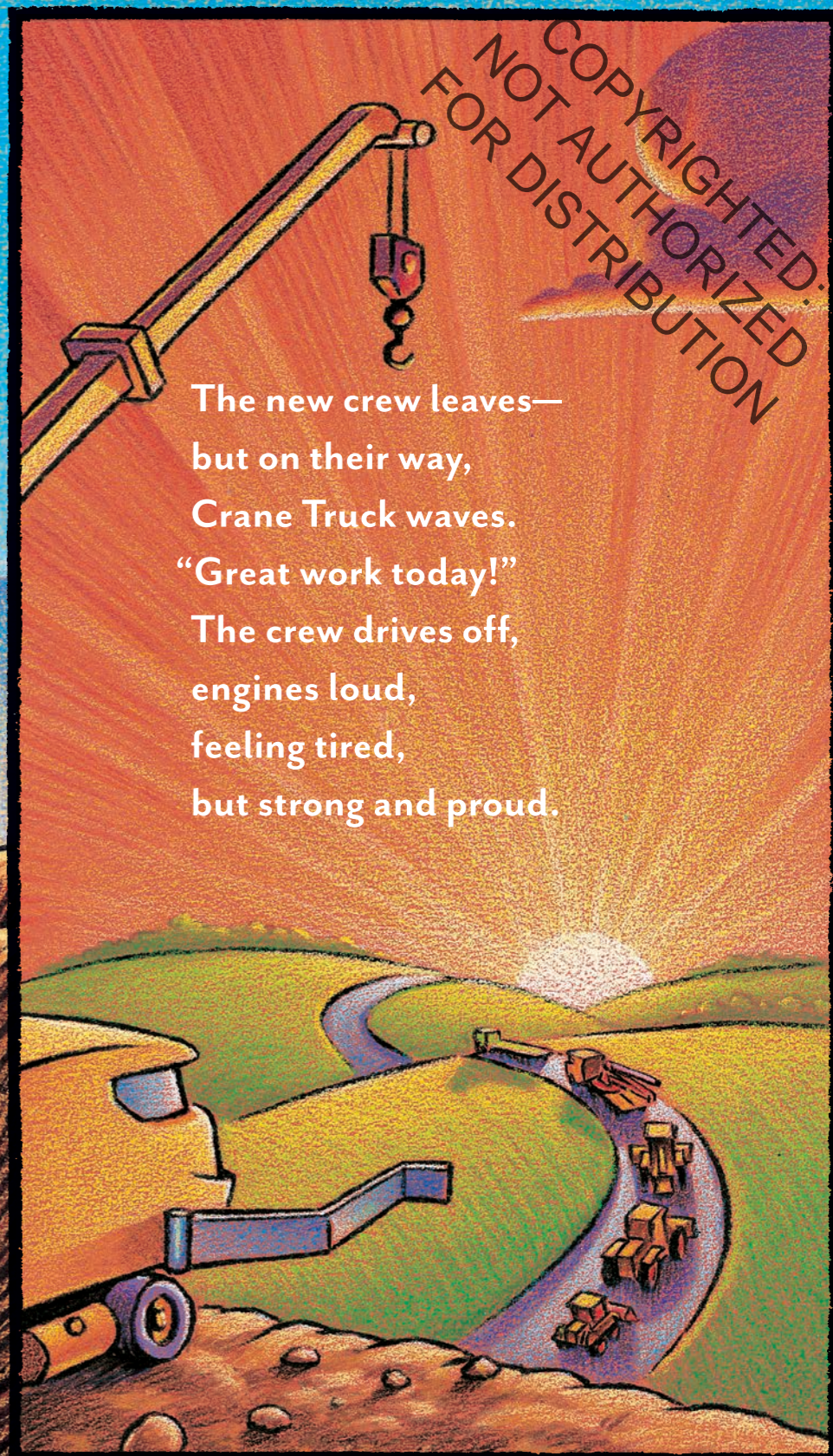
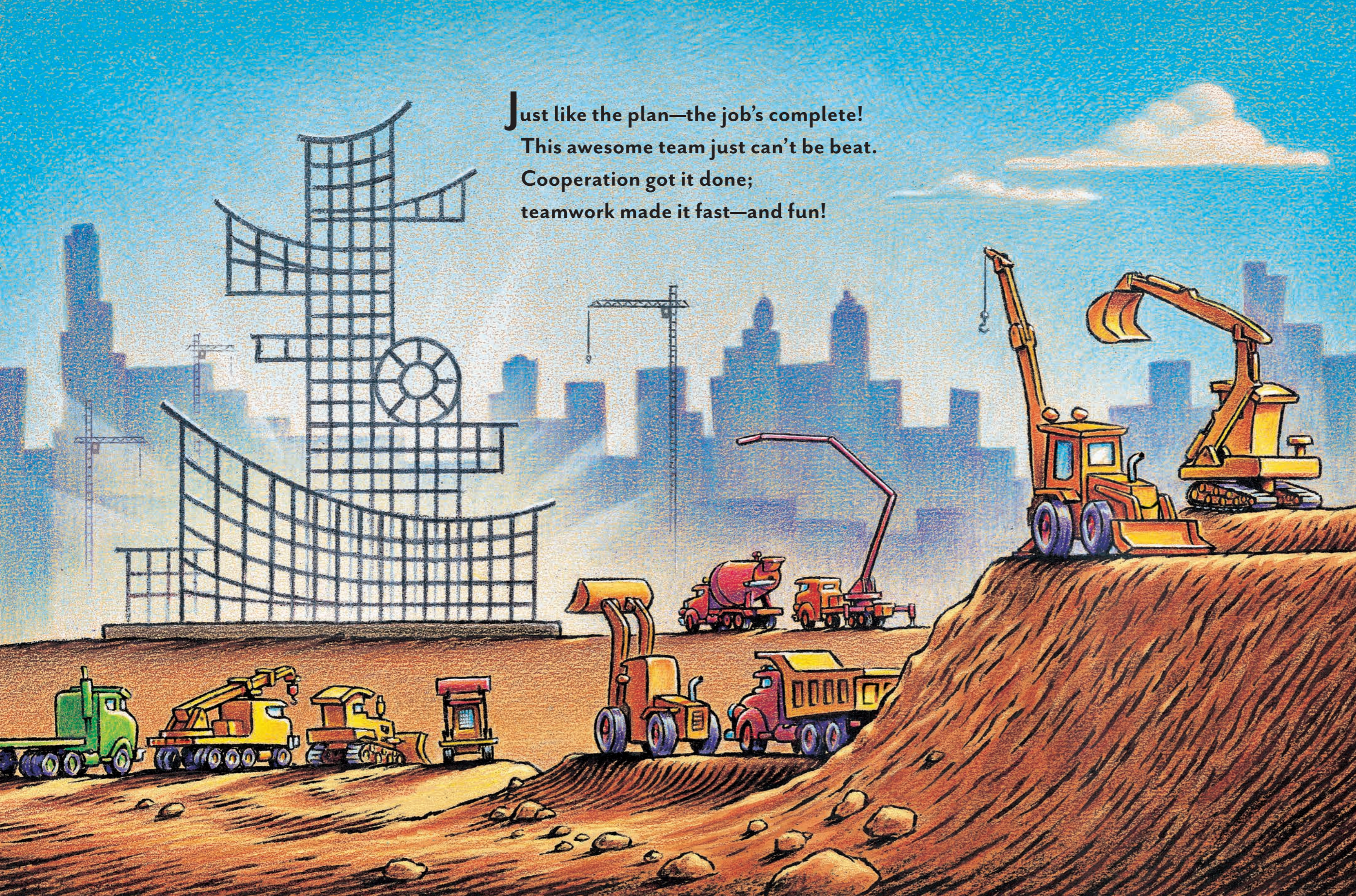


Rough and rugged all day long,
