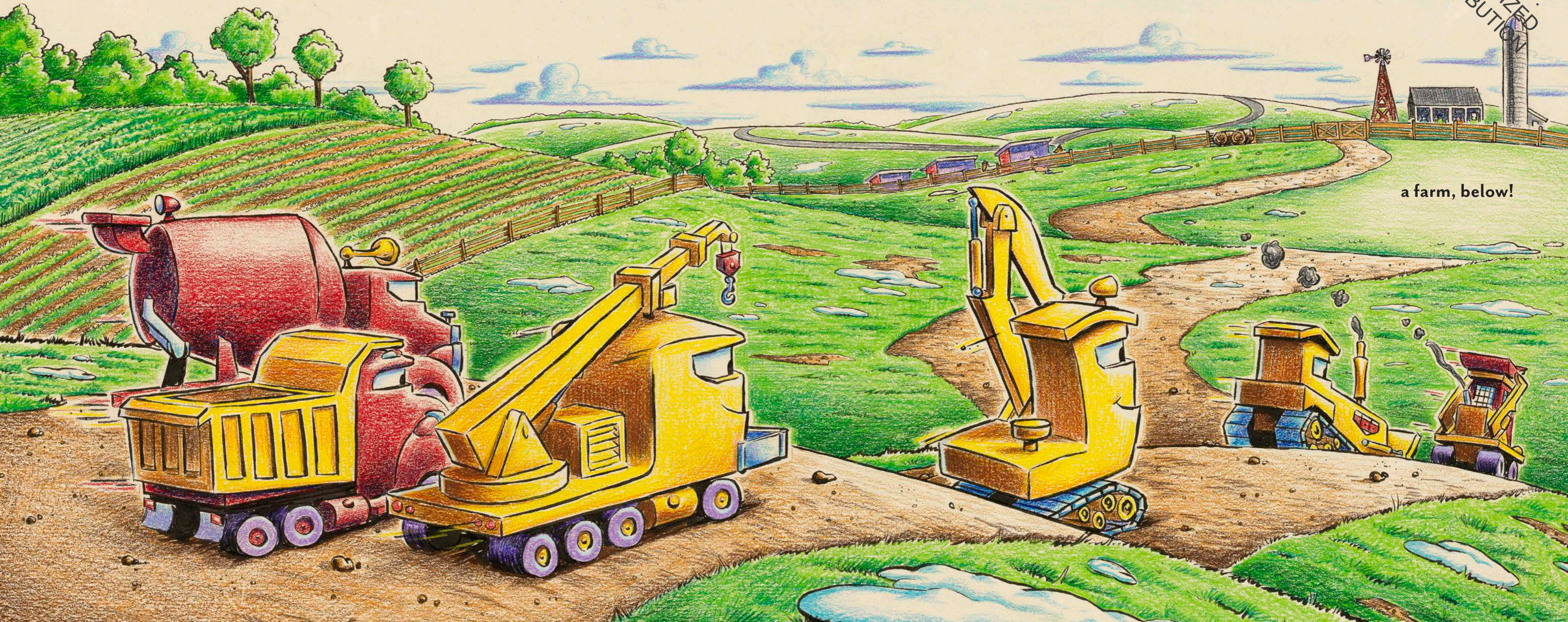


It's early spring, the day's begun,

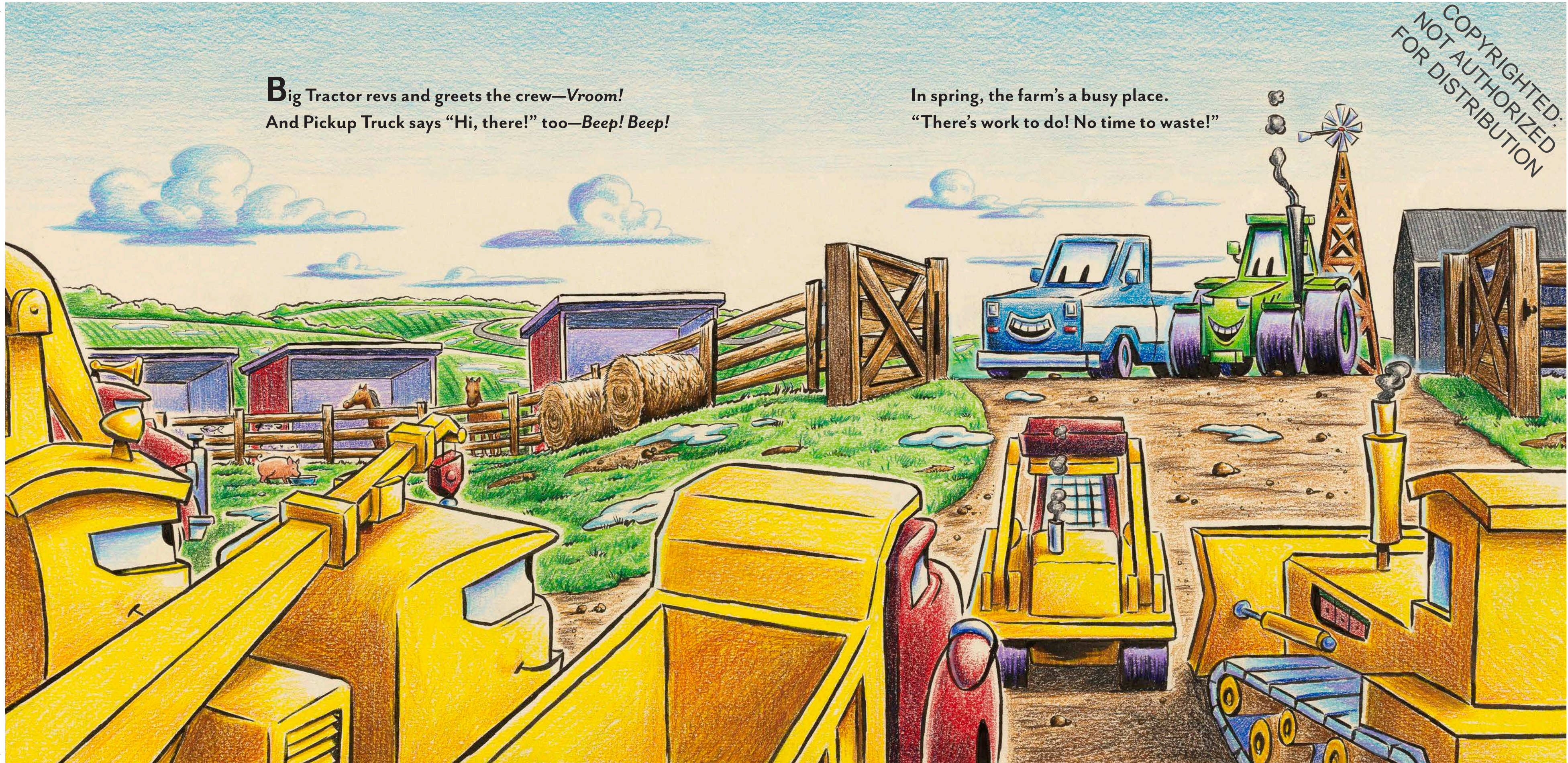

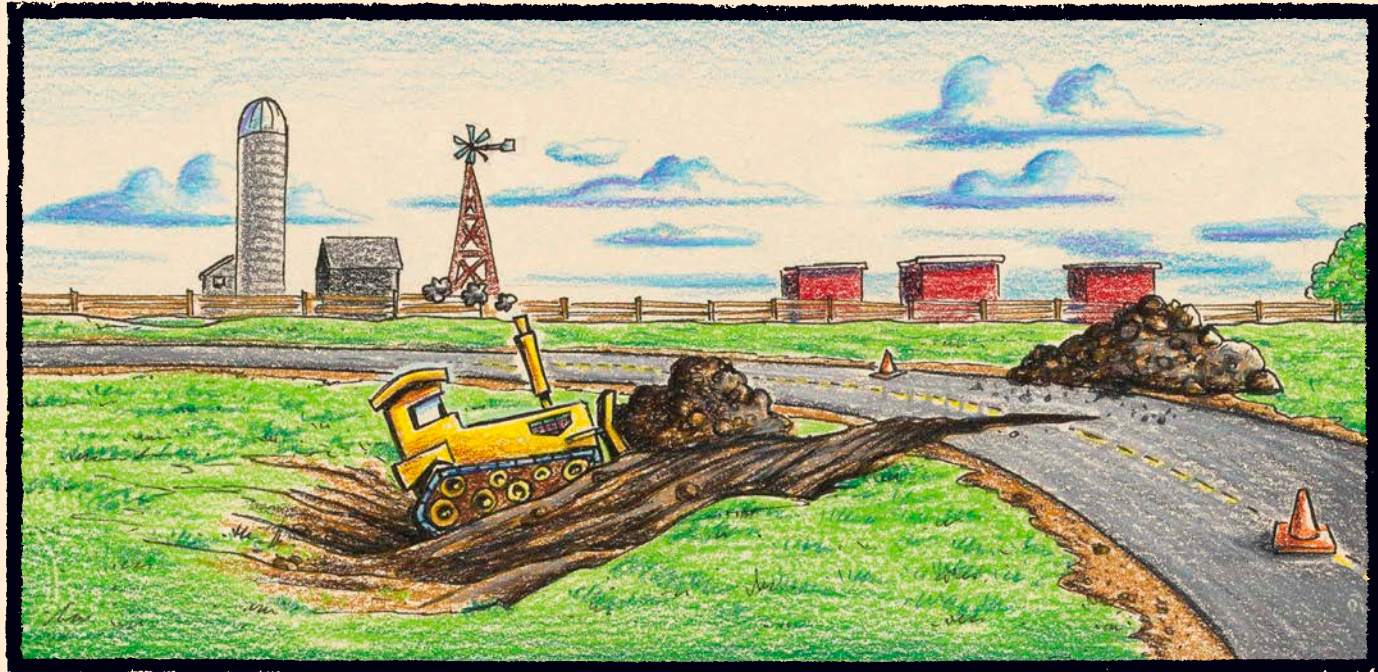


Big Tractor revs and greets the crew—*Vroom!*
And Pickup Truck says “Hi, there!” too—*Beep! Beep!*

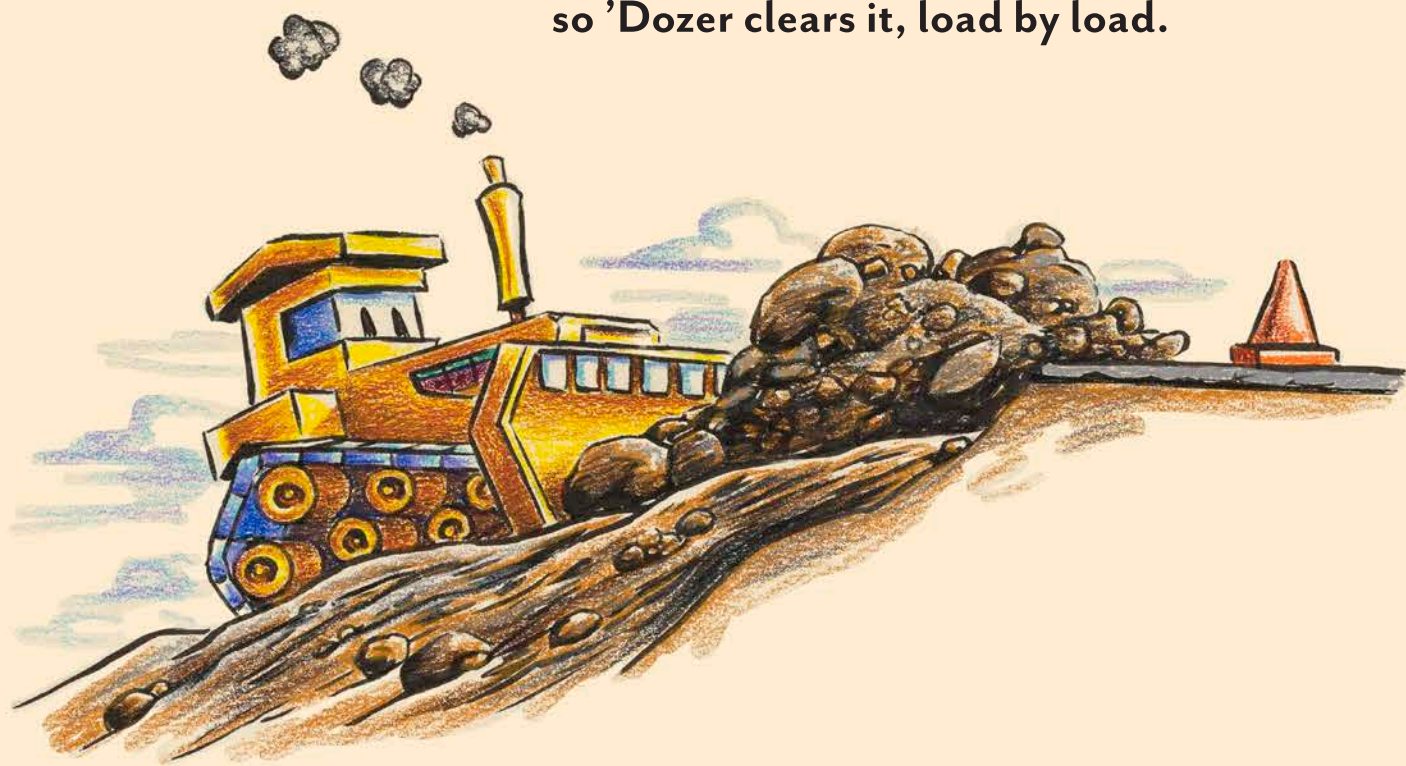
In spring, the farm’s a busy place.

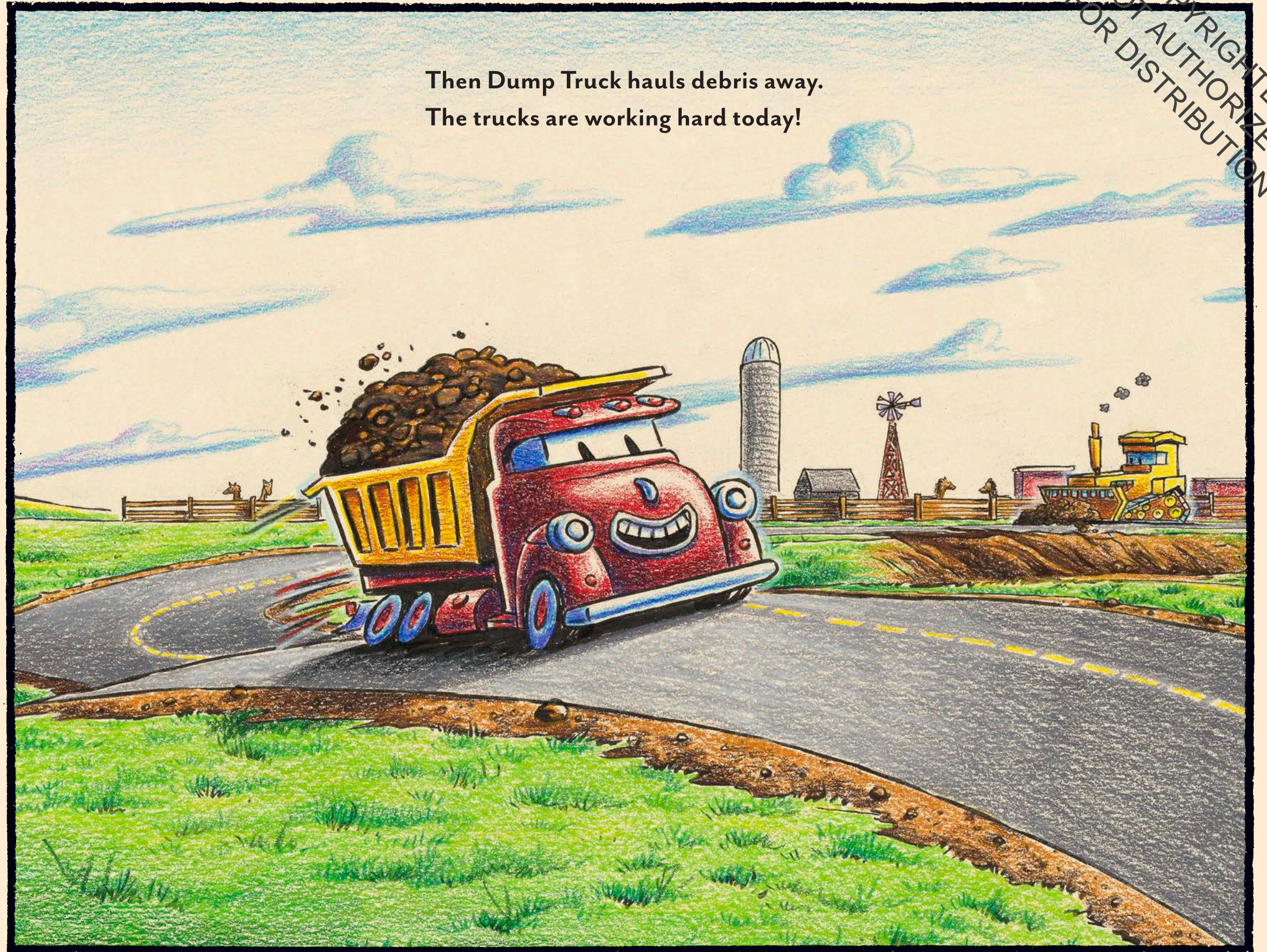




A springtime washout blocked a road,
so 'Dozer clears it, load by load.

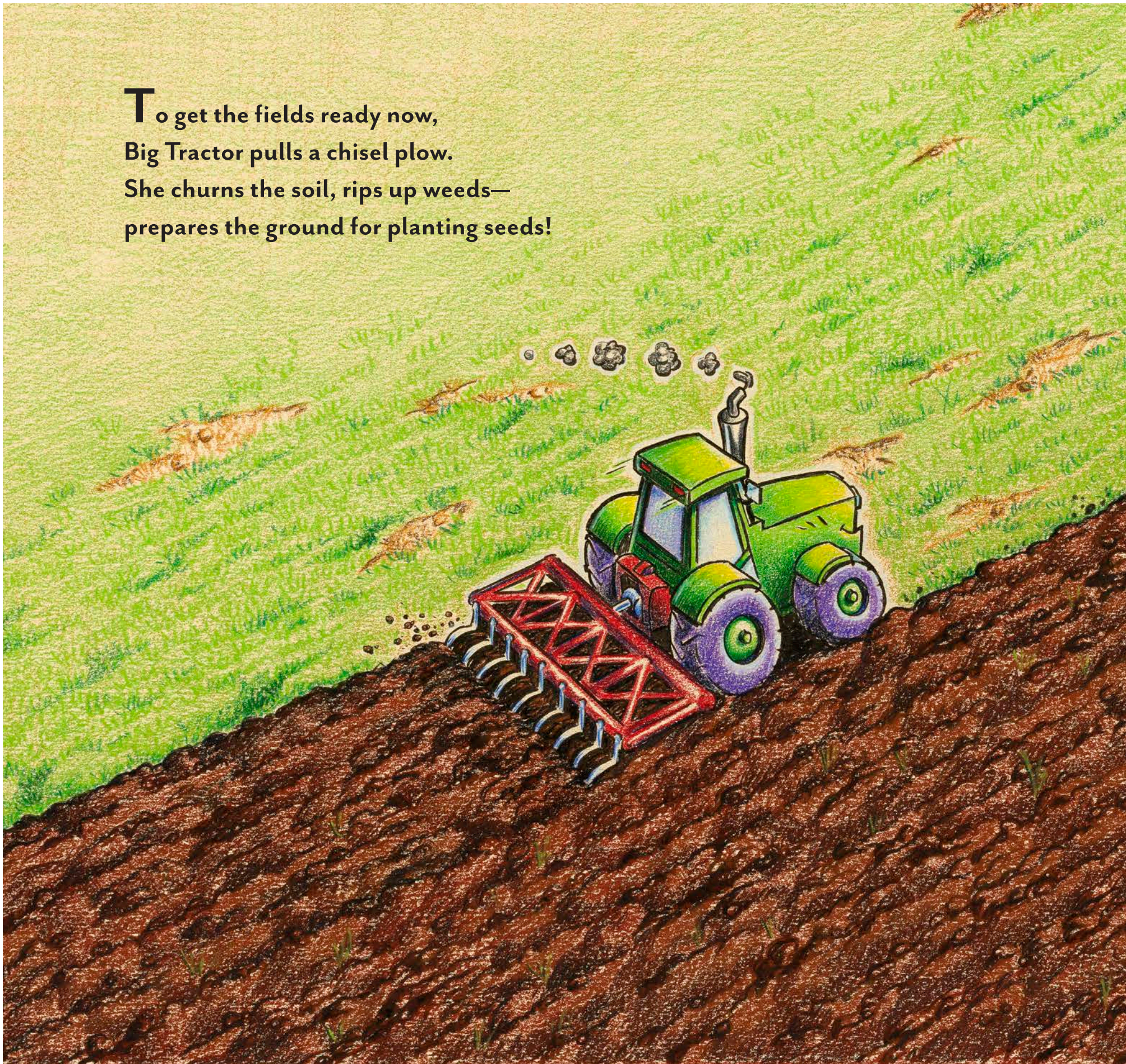


Then Dump Truck hauls debris away.
The trucks are working hard today!

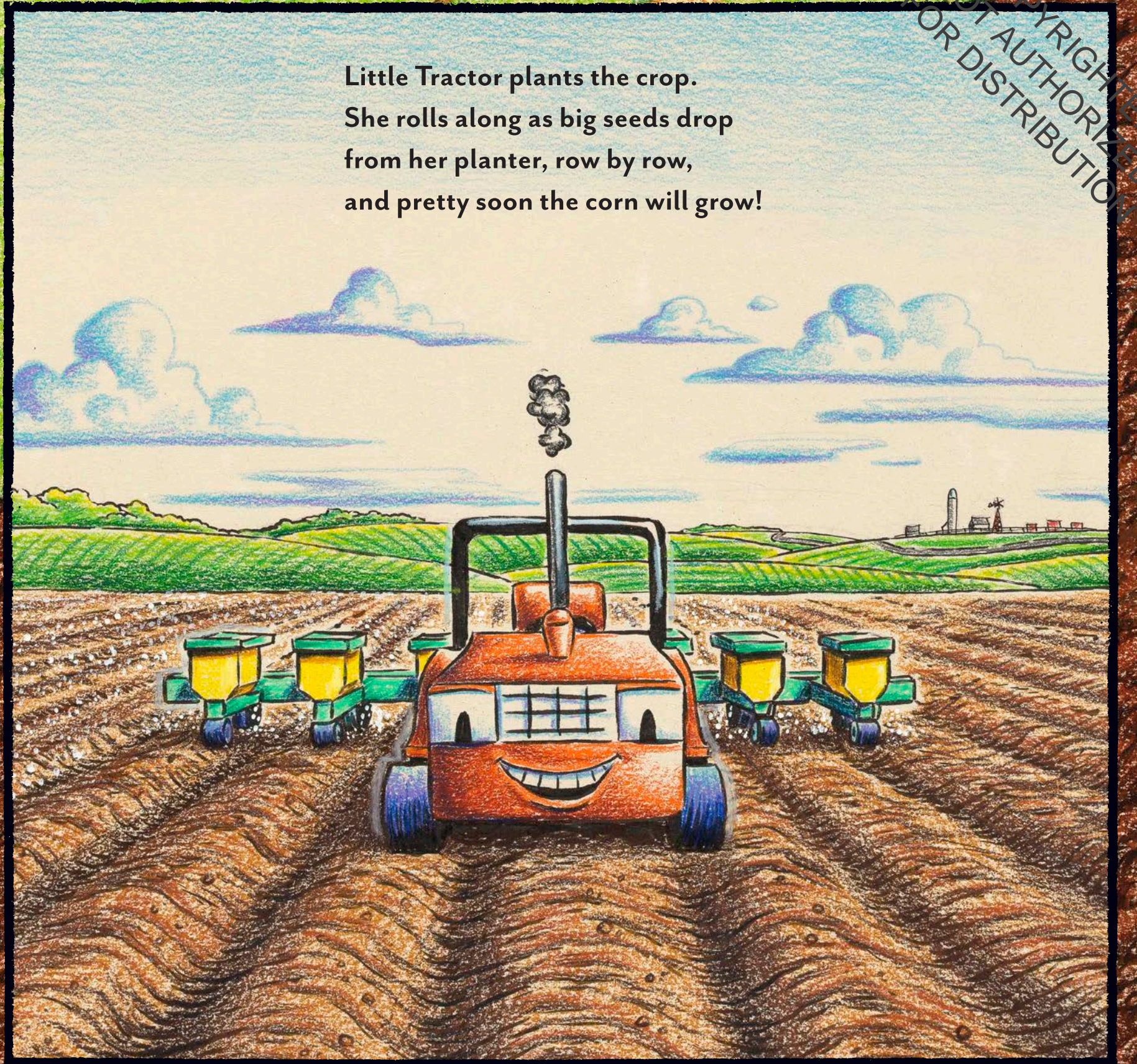

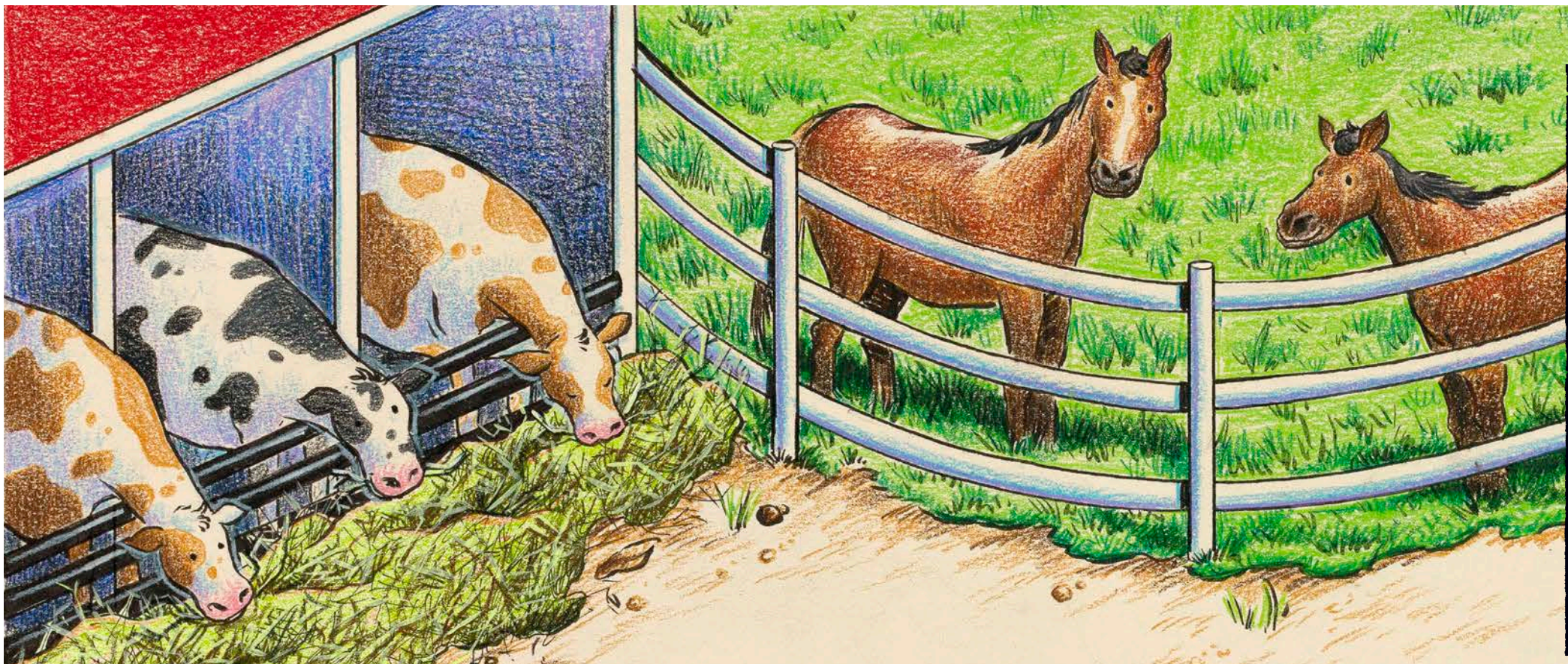
To get the fields ready now,

prepares the ground for planting seeds!



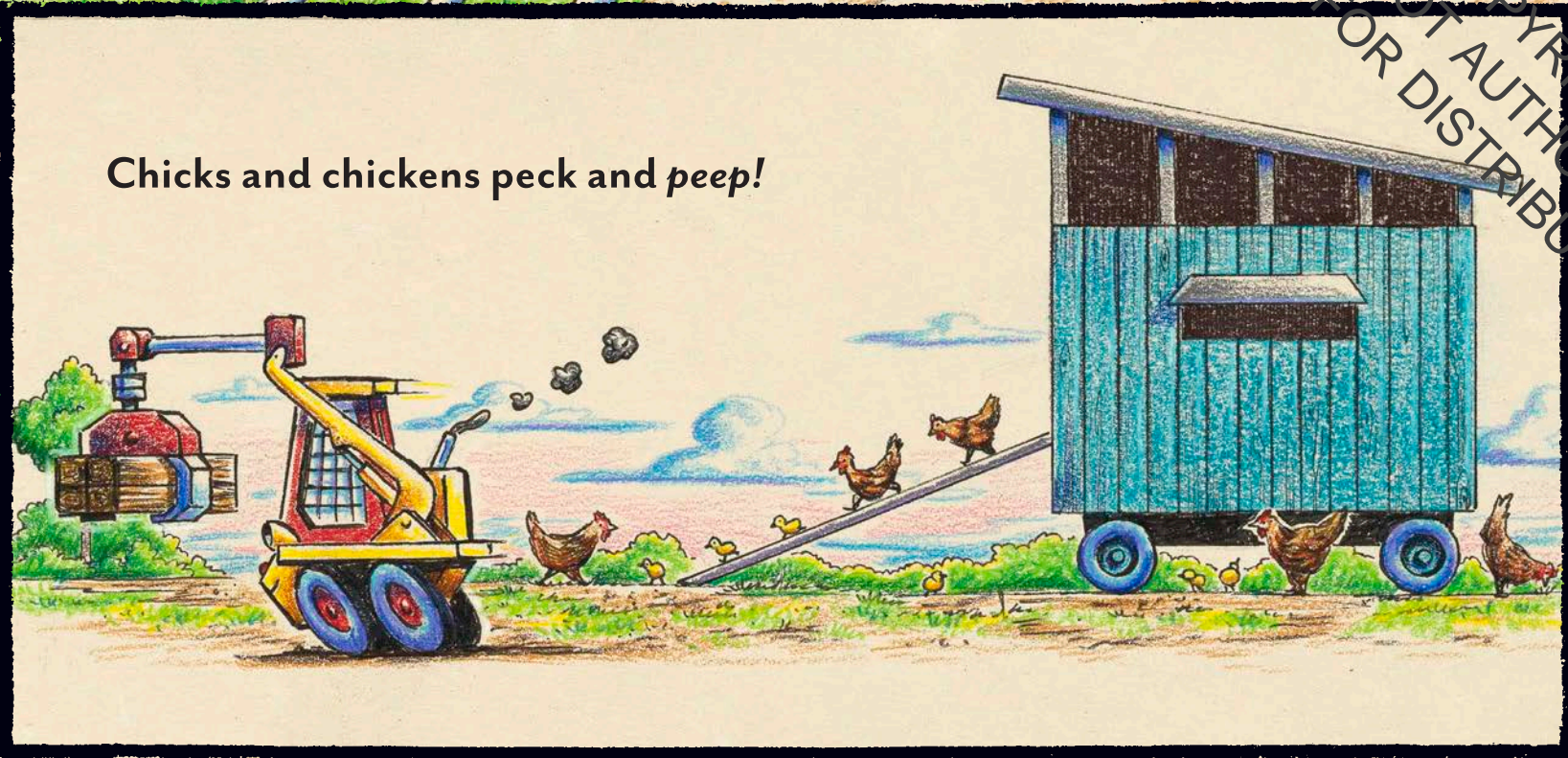
Little Tractor plants the crop.

and pretty soon the corn will grow!



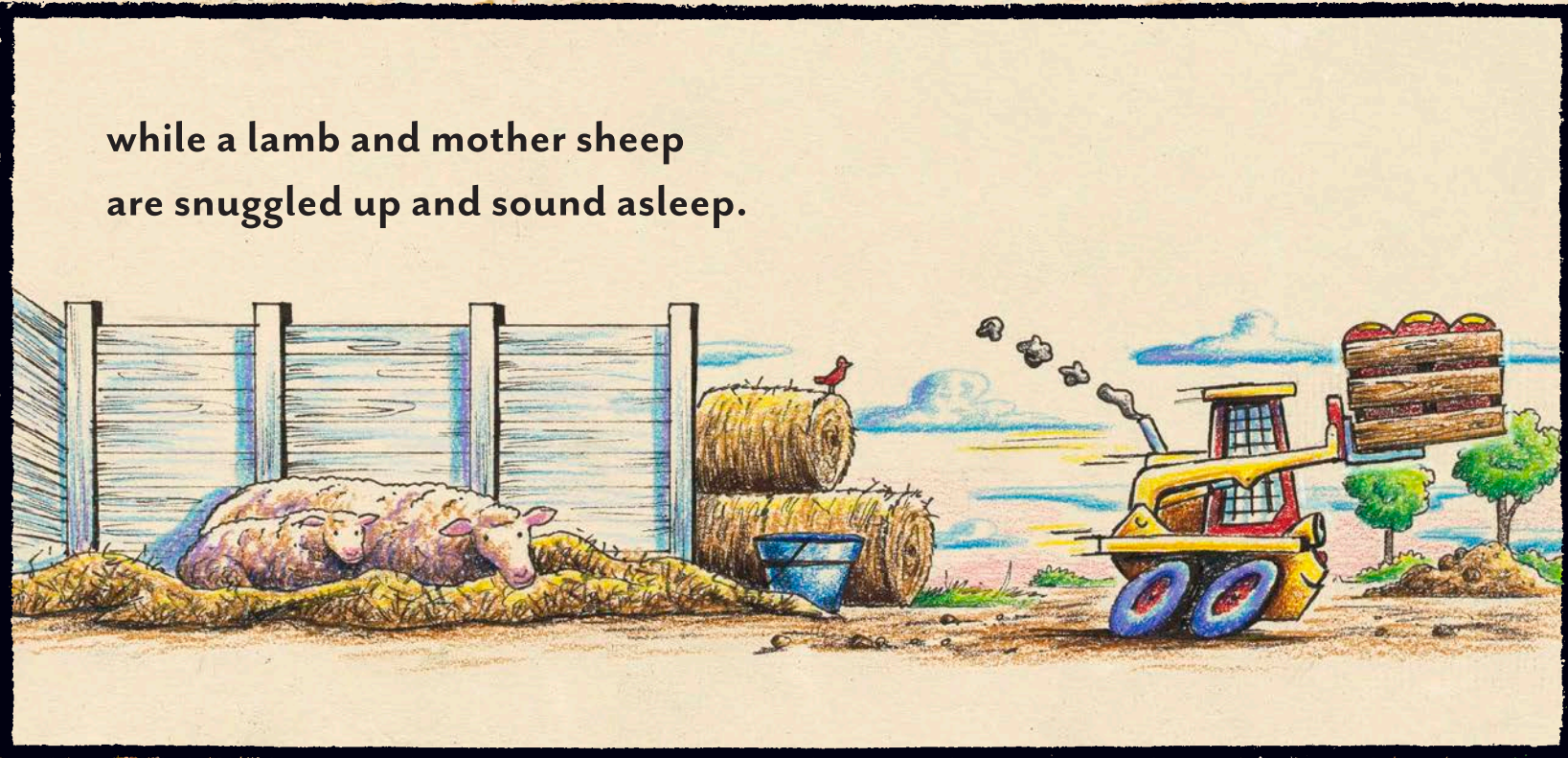

the balers help to roll them up!

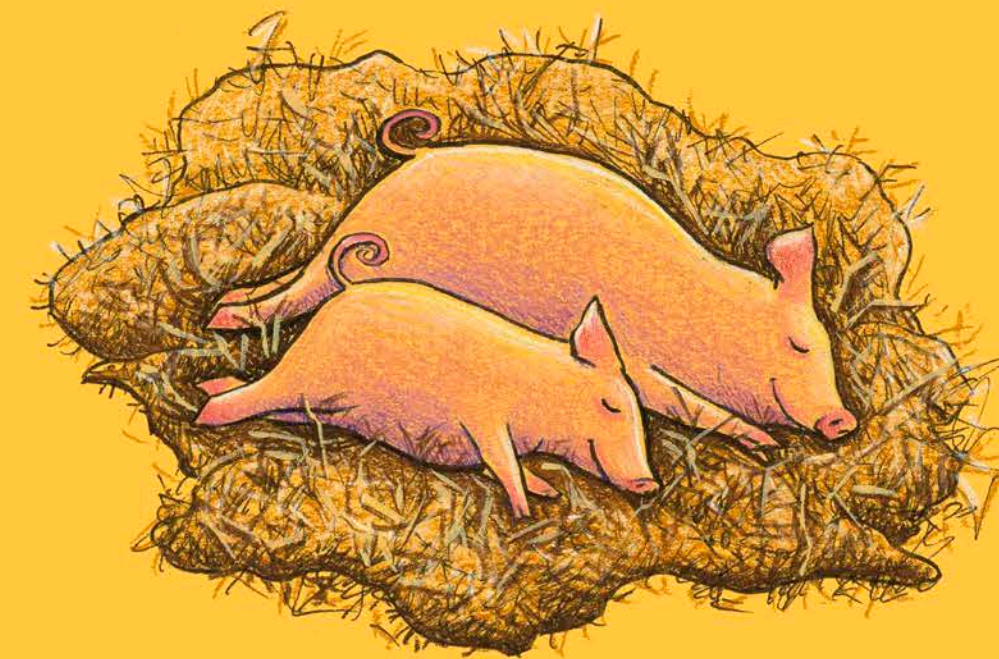
Then the bales dry in the sun.
They'll be hauled in when they're all done.



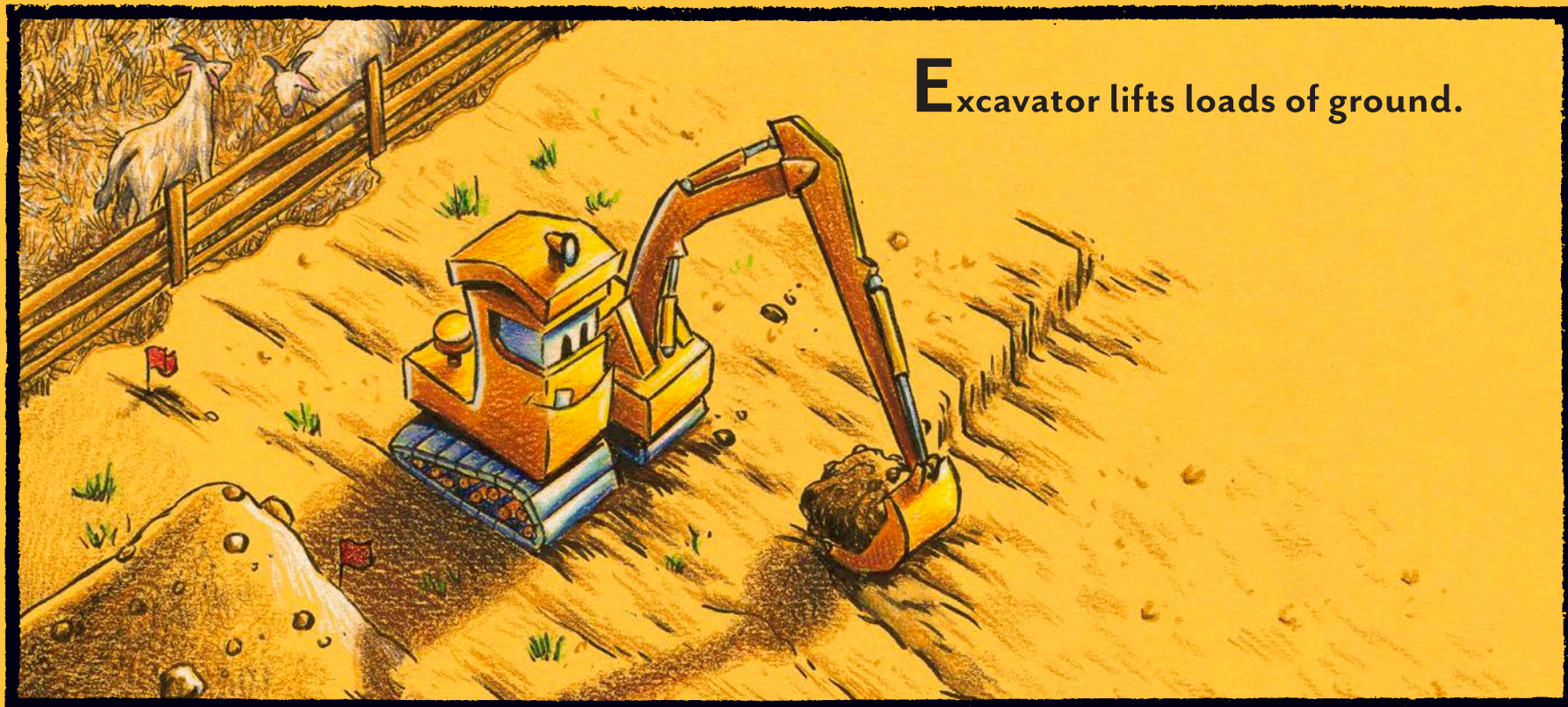
Hay for food and straw for beds,

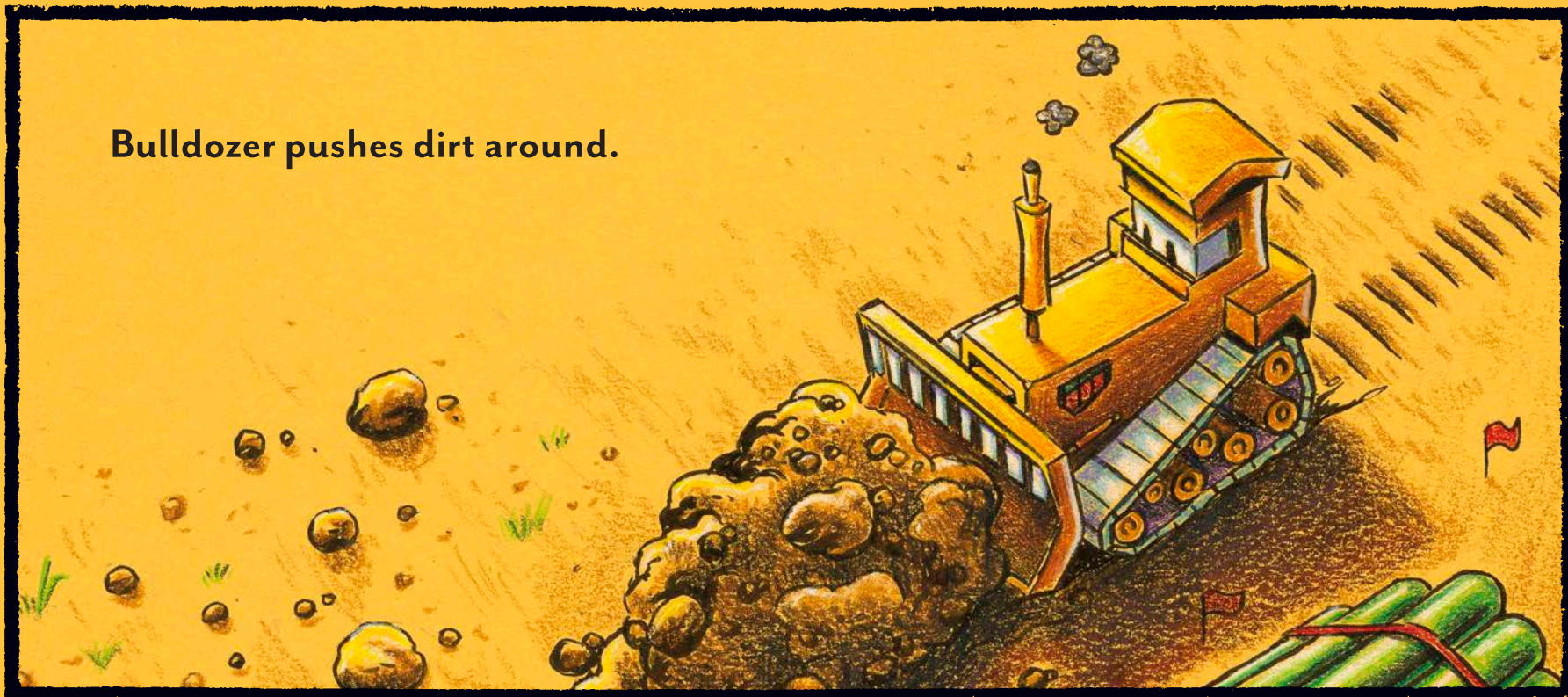


Excavator lifts loads of ground.

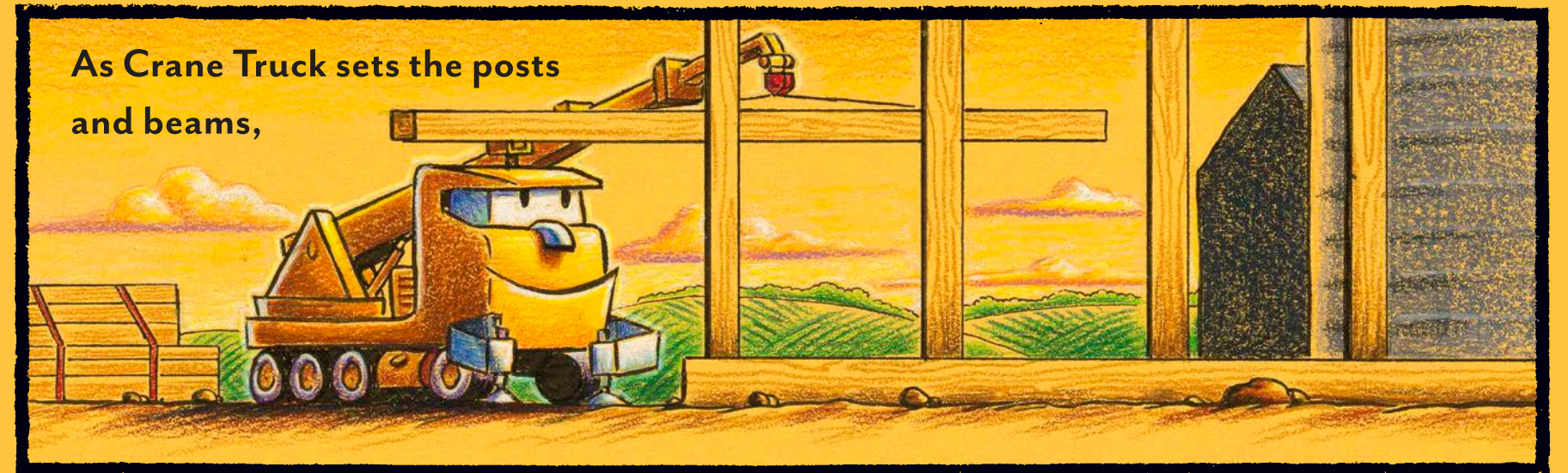


Skid Steer makes her auger spin,

Bulldozer pushes dirt around.

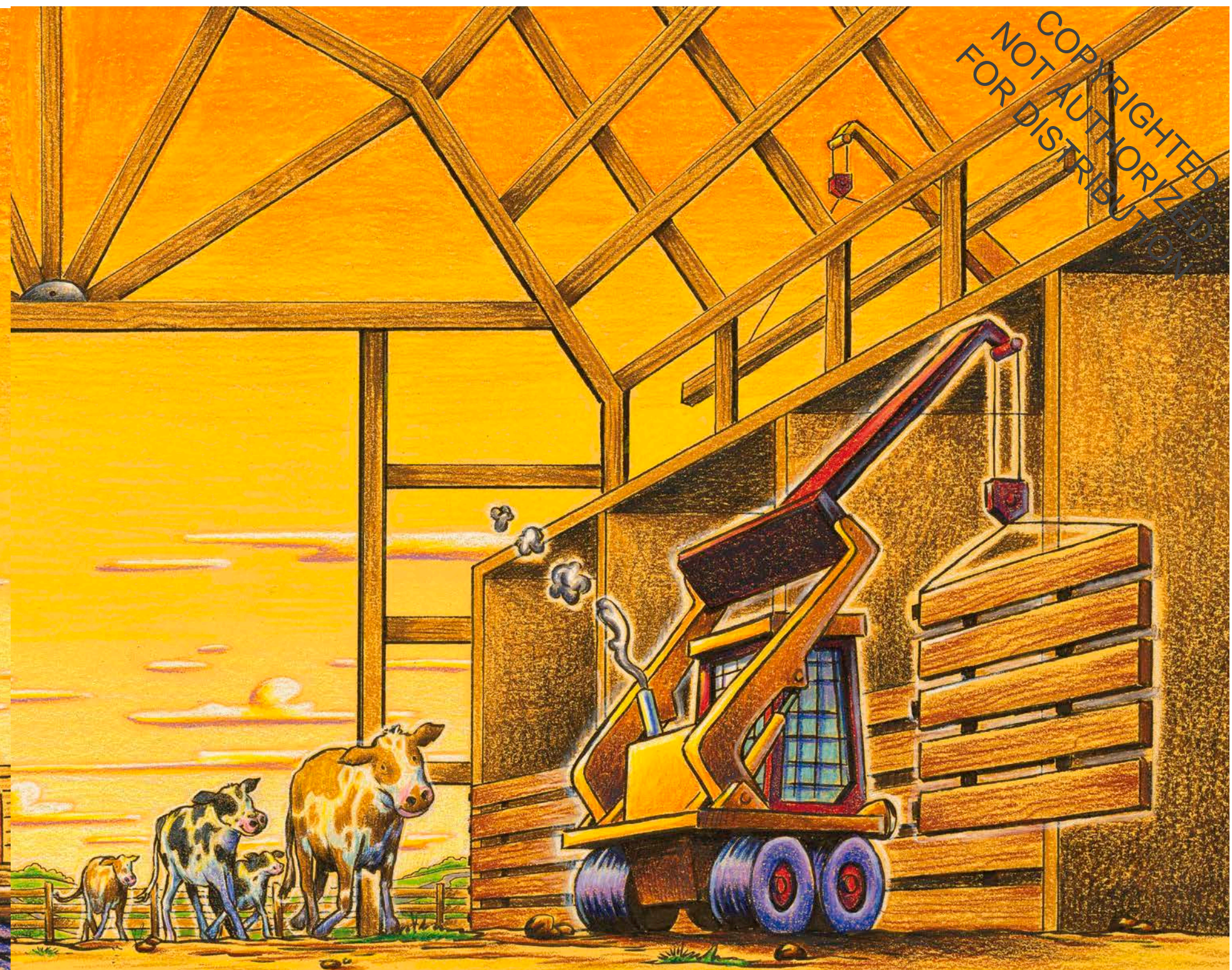


As Crane Truck sets the posts

a smooth and sturdy concrete floor!



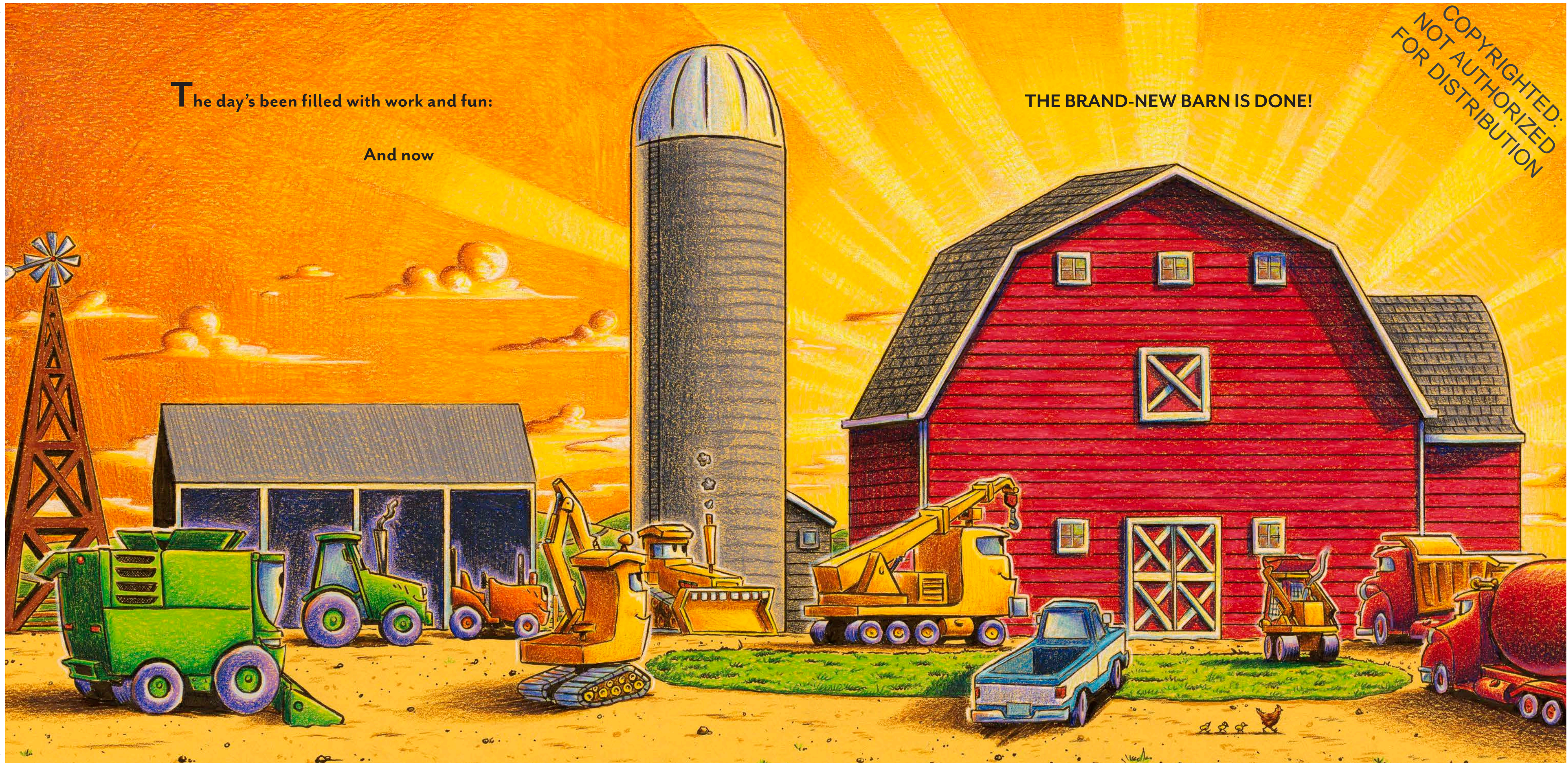
**Then Skid Steer puts in all the stalls.

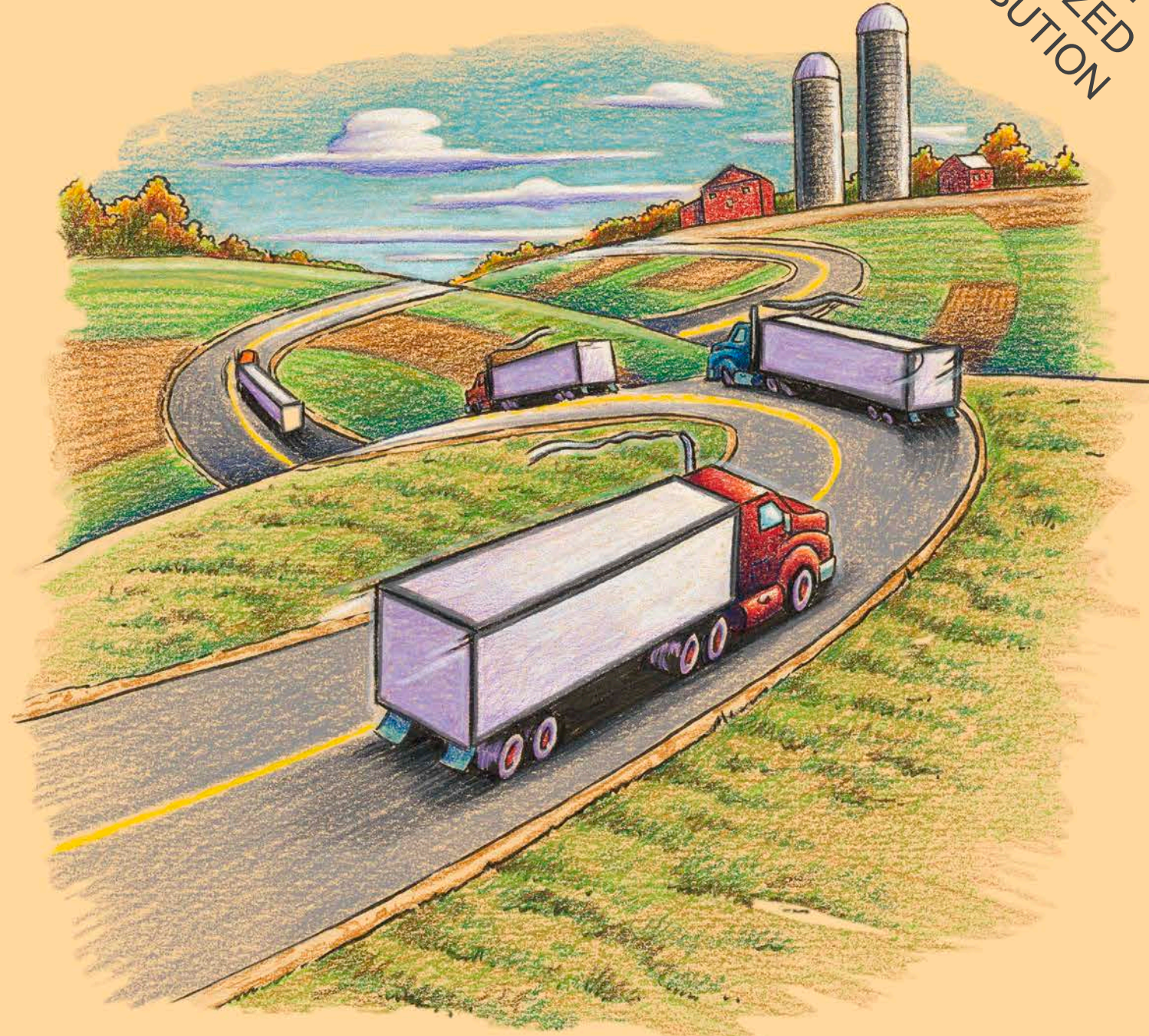

She rolls with Combine, all aligned.

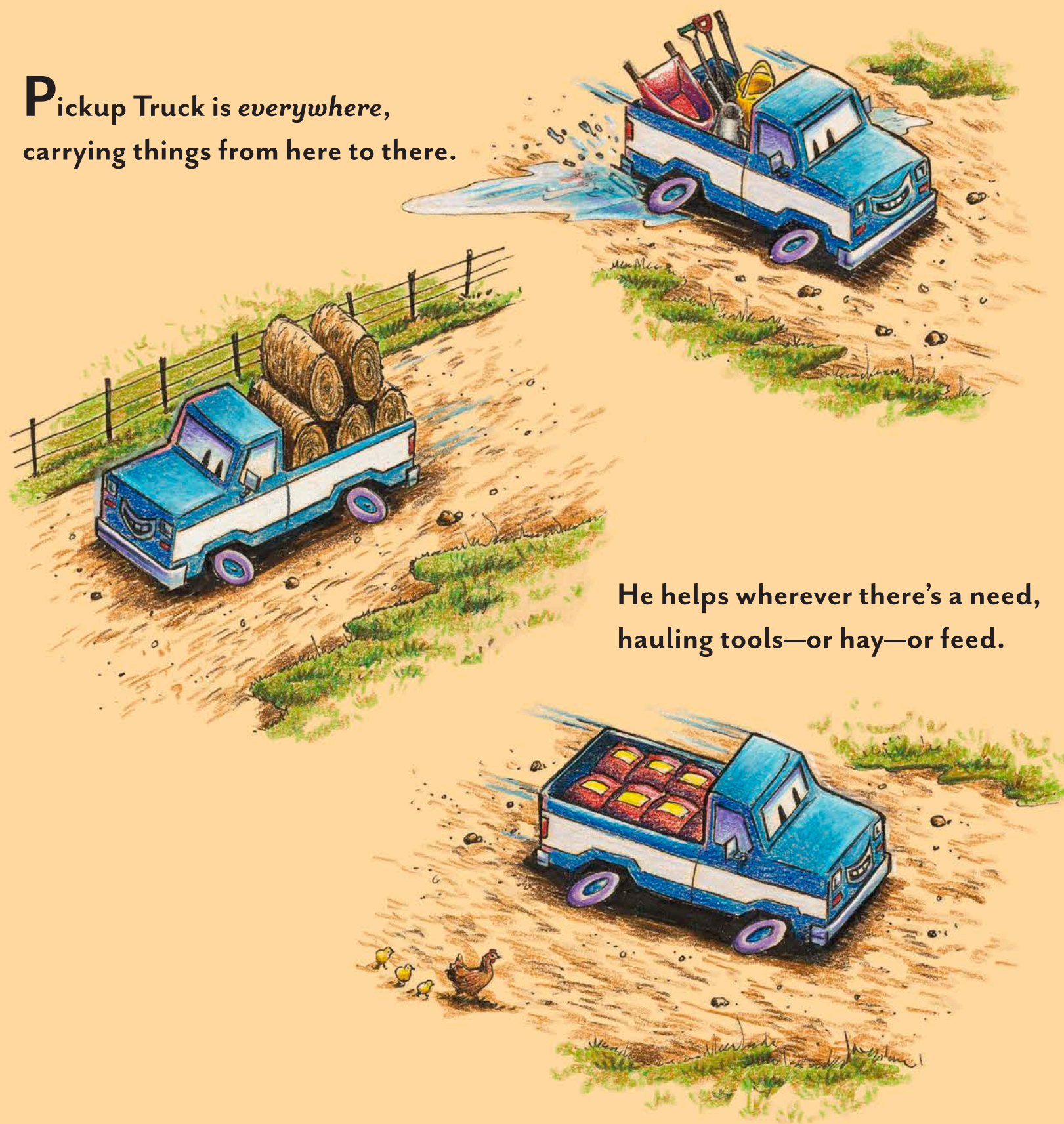


Auger lifts the grain up high—

semitrucks take grain to town.

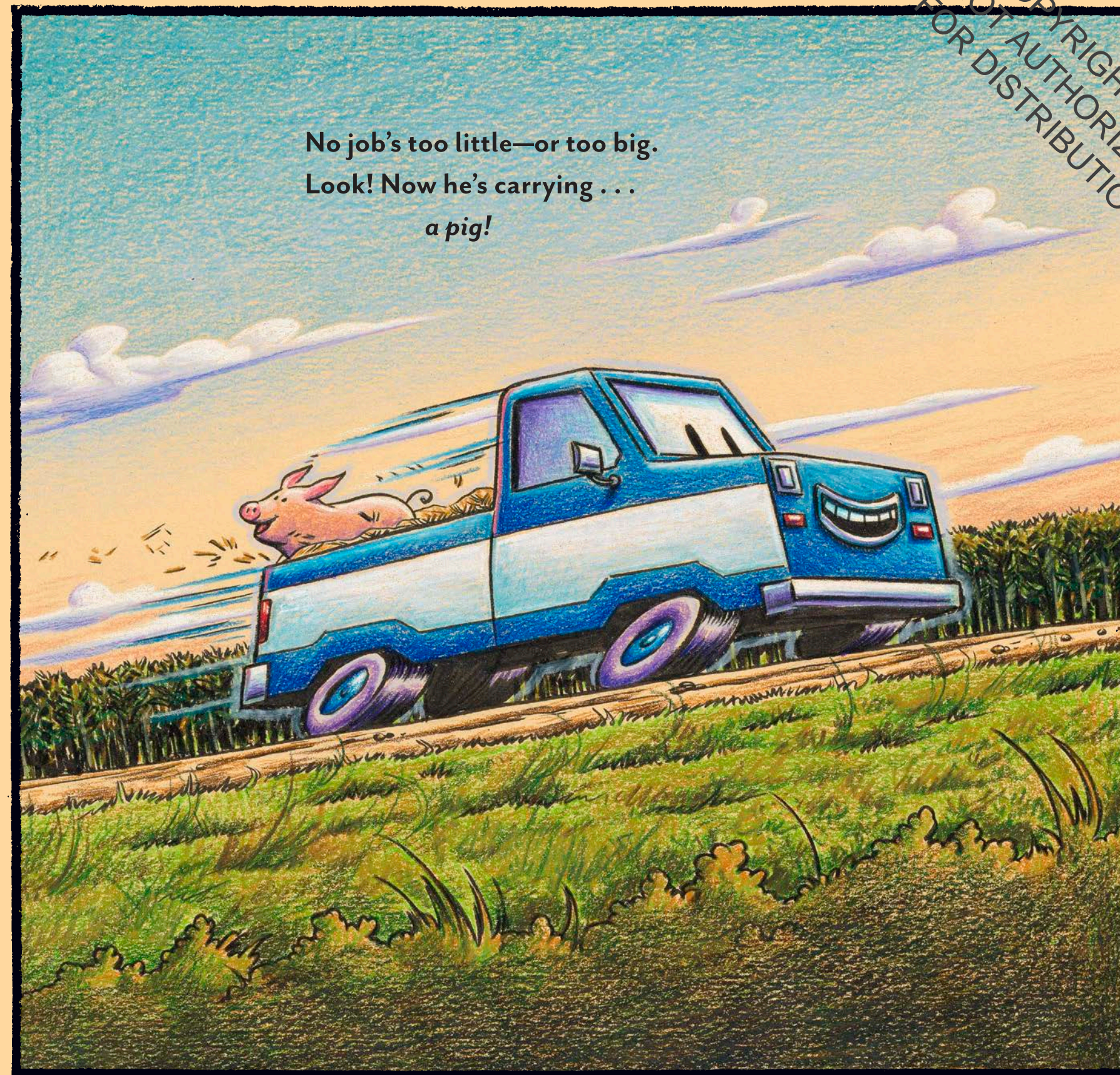


Pickup Truck is *everywhere*,

from dawn to dusk—and then they're done!

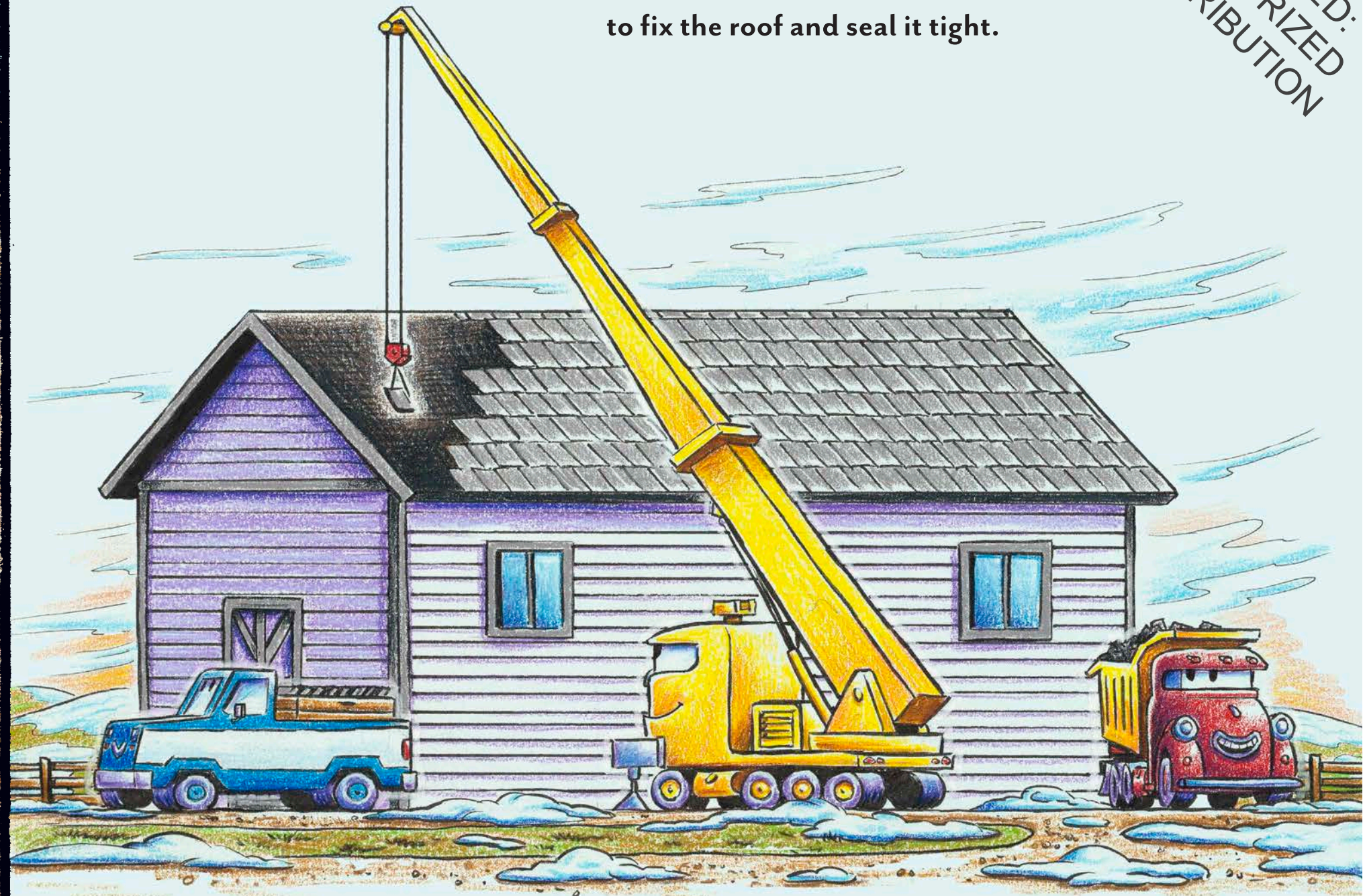

to fix the roof and seal it tight.



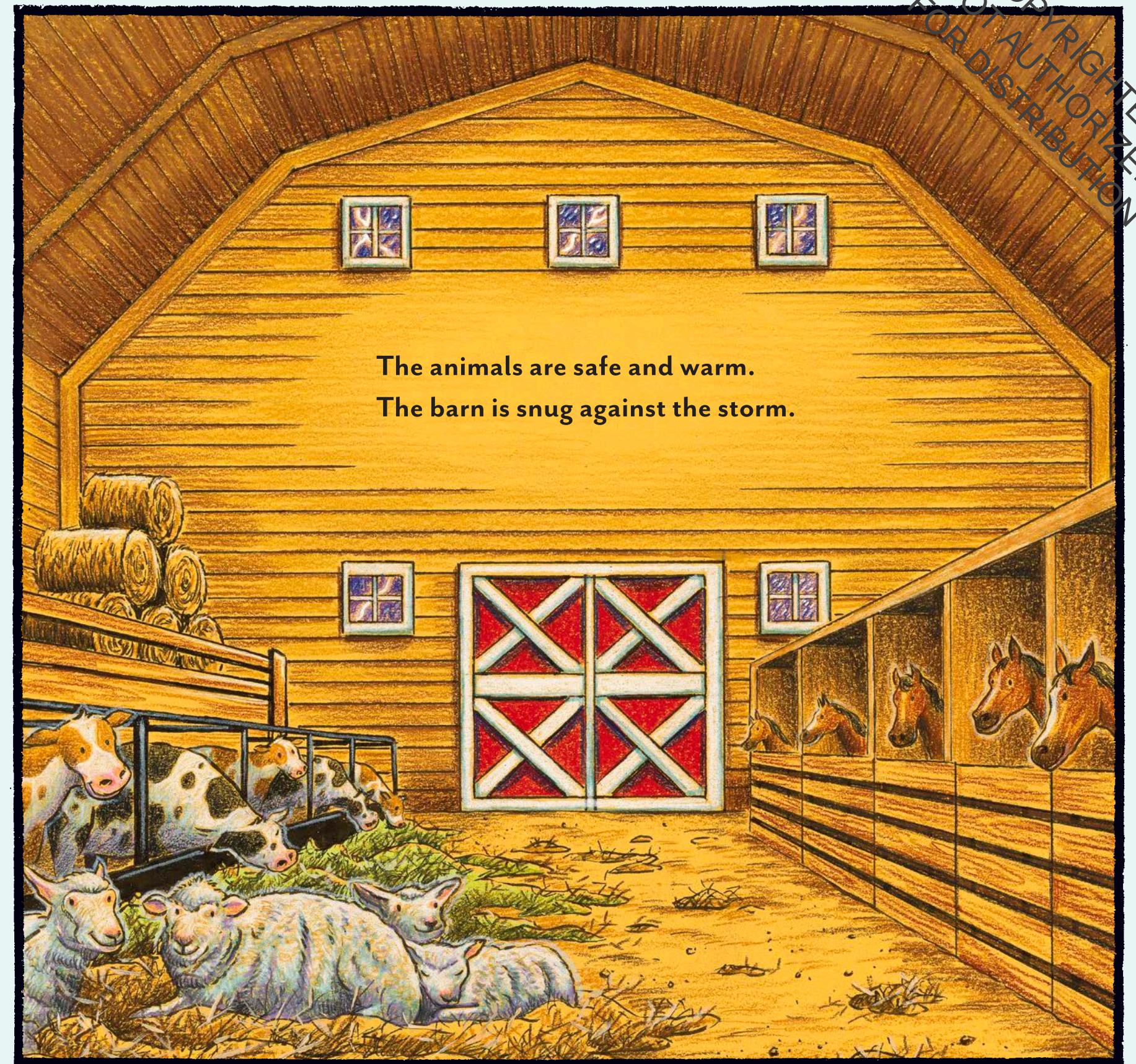
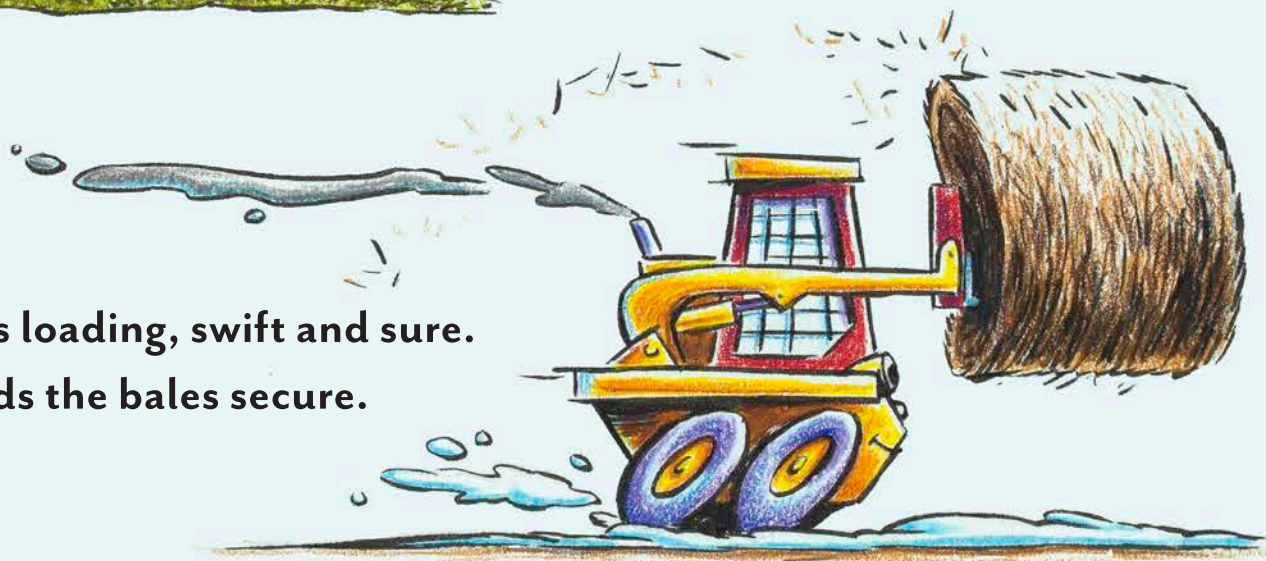

Her forklift holds the bales secure.

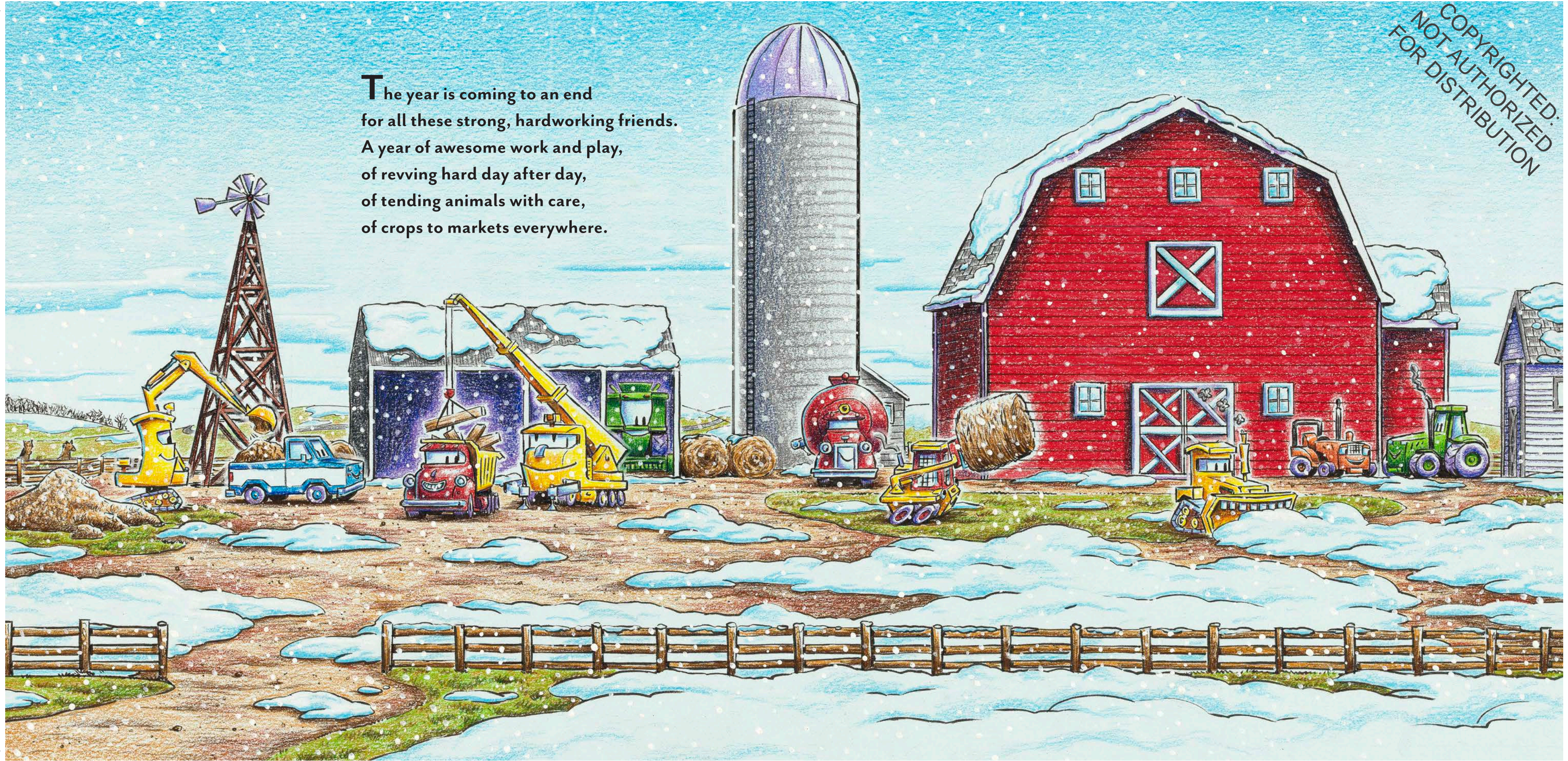


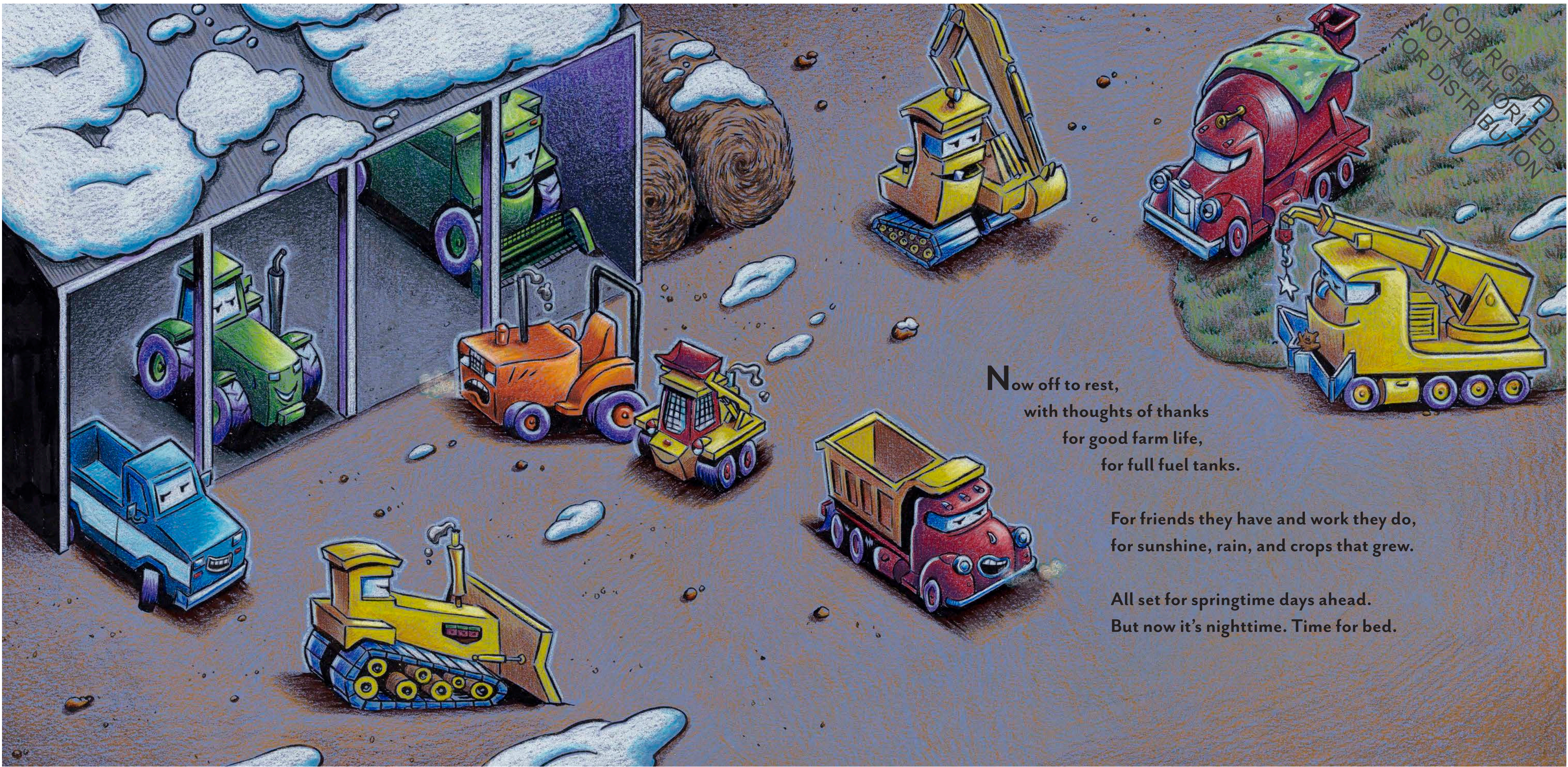
