into their lab.



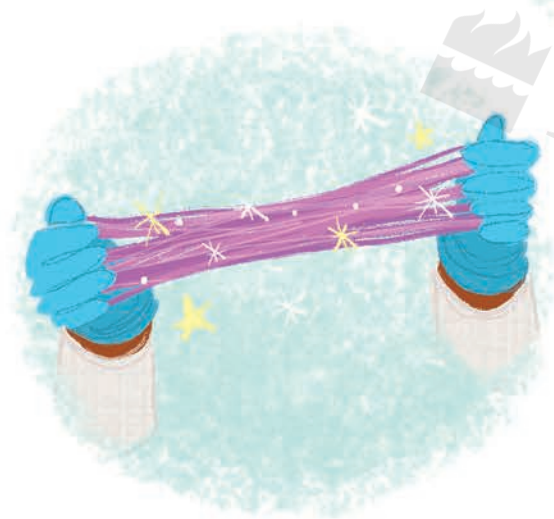
Momma gets out bowls
