



Corey does, too.


They can't wait for Momma to take them to the museum.

Oh no! Momma sees a sign.


Ty is too little.

Ty walks away slowly.








Ty and Corey hunt for fossils.

Daddy sets up a table.


Ty and Corey walk into their lab.
