GROUP CRAFT INSTRUCTIONS

Think big! Create a giant Humpty Dumpty!

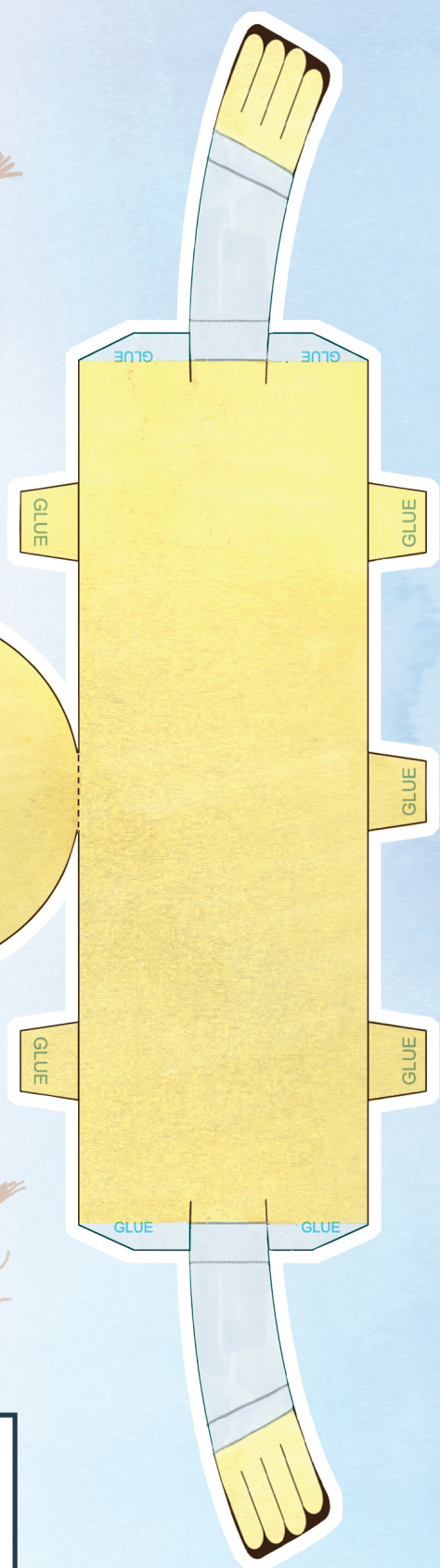
Materials:

Two poster-size pieces of card stock
Markers
Scissors
Paint
Construction paper
Ribbon
Glue



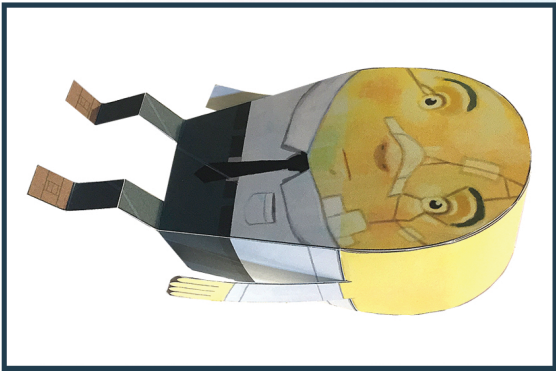
Instructions:

- Step 1:** On one piece of cardstock, draw the top of a large oval with a large rectangle at the bottom (this will be the shape of Humpty sitting on the wall) and cut out your drawing. **Tip:** Be sure to fill most of the card stock with your shape. Continue to draw the bottom of the oval within the rectangle you made.
- Step 2:** With an adult's help, trace and cut this same shape on the second piece of card stock. This will be the back of the costume.
- Step 3:** Paint the rectangle to look like a brick wall. **Tip:** Paint smaller rectangles so that the red space in between looks like mortar. Use the same brick design on the other side of the cut out.
- Step 4:** Draw pants and a shirt on the part of the oval that spills onto the rectangle, and then draw a face on Humpty. Draw the back of the pants and shirt on the other piece of cardstock. **Tip:** Do not paint the brick design on this part.
- Step 5:** Using construction paper that matches the color of Humpty's pants, cut two long pieces to make legs. Repeat to create two arms for Humpty. Glue the legs and arms onto Humpty's body.
- Step 6:** Cut two smaller rectangles from construction paper to make shoes for Humpty. Glue these onto the bottom of Humpty's legs.
- Step 7:** Connect the front and back cutouts by taping a long ribbon on Humpty's right side (connecting front and back), and then a second ribbon on the left (connecting front and back). Leave enough room so the costume can be slipped over your head.



HUMPTY DUMPTY

Make your own Humpty Dumpty Dumpty using the template above! Use scissors to cut out the Humpty Dumpty Dumpty template on the solid lines. Then fold on the dotted lines where indicated, and use glue to carefully secure the tabs.

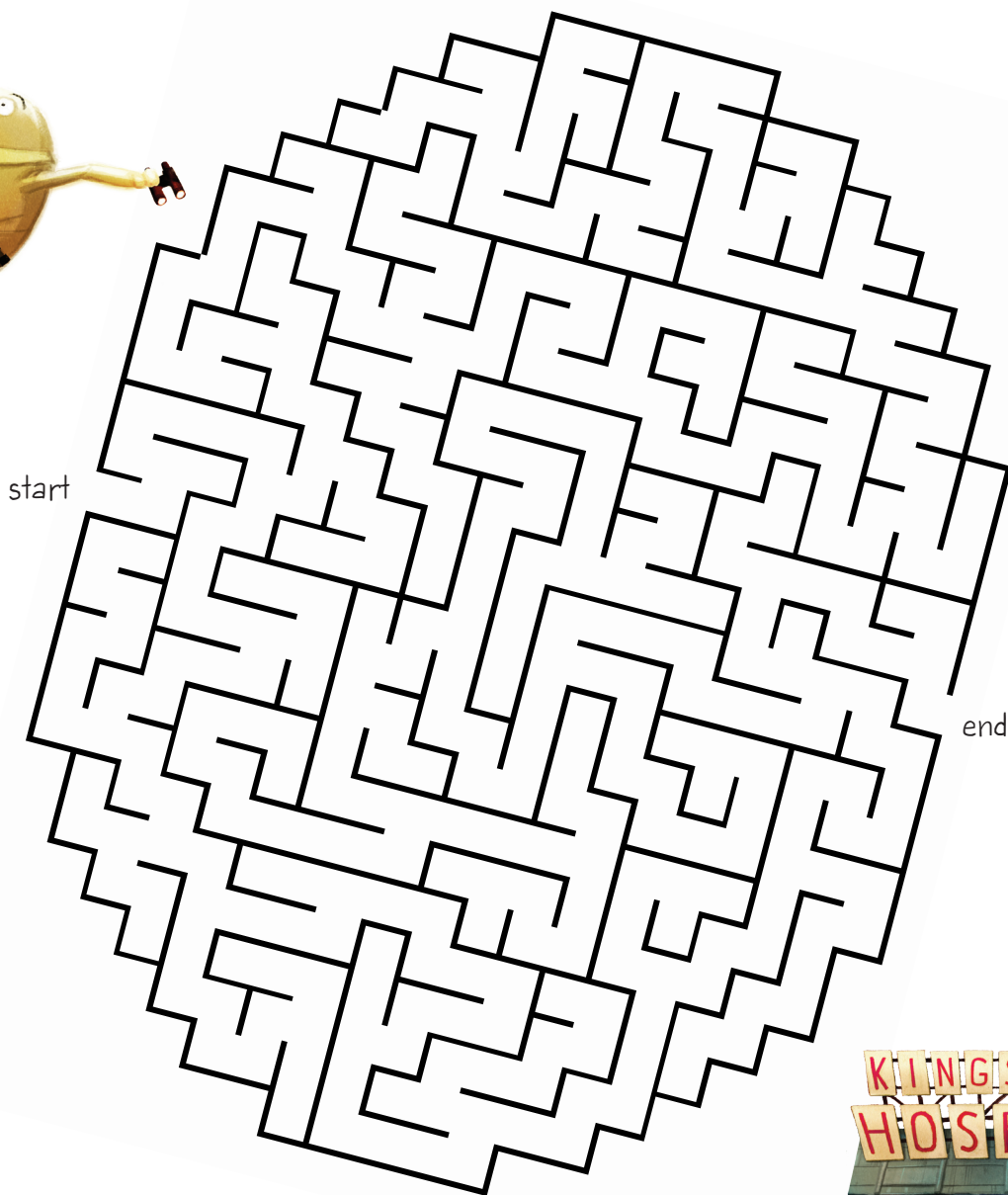
SPOT THE DIFFERENCE!

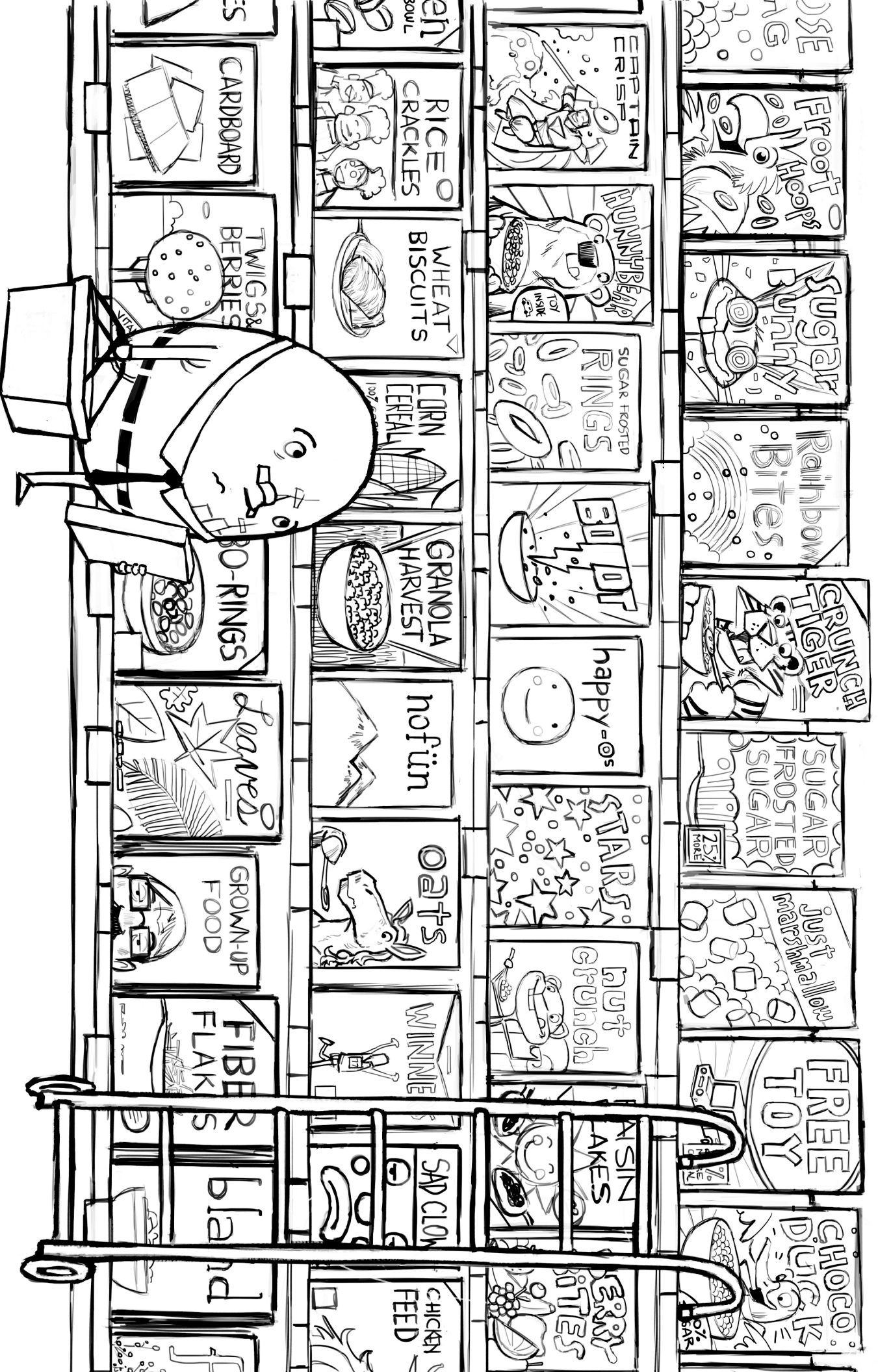
