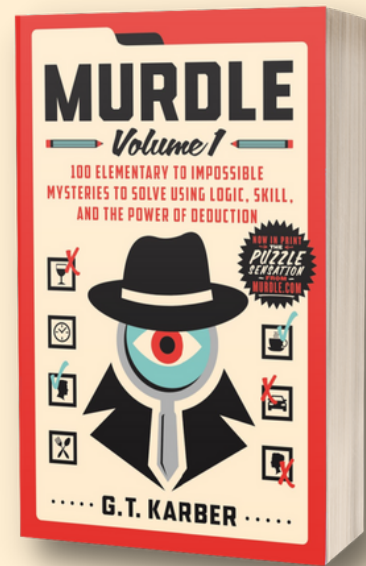


How to solve MURDLE



Case No. 2: 'And Then There Was Another One'

Full puzzle, Exhibit A, and additional assets are available for download on Edelweiss.

To solve a murdle, you must go clue by clue. The first reads, **The suspect who brought an ordinary brick was a parishioner of Father Mango's.** Logically, all this clue proves is that Father Mango did *not* have the brick. So put an X in the box where Father Mango and the brick intersect.

The second clue reads, **Miss Saffron had a bear trap in her purse.** Put a checkmark in the box where Miss Saffron and the bear trap intersect, and put Xs in the other boxes in that row and column. By process of elimination, you can see that Father Mango must have had the harpoon, leaving the brick for Signor Emerald.

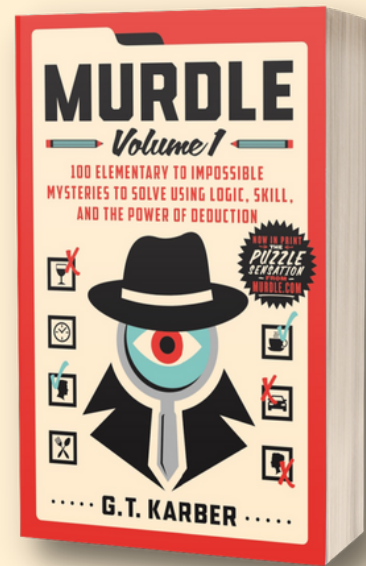
MURDLE: Volume 1

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The third clue reads, **The suspect whose family’s company produced Logico’s magnifying glass was literally hanging around the cliffs. (See Exhibit A.)** According to Exhibit A—a list of the items in Logico's Detective Kit—the Emerald Family Company manufactured Logico's magnifying glass, which means that Signor Emerald was on the cliffs.
