Event Suggestions

- Set out snacks (pineapple, pastries, pretzels, etc.) and encourage kids to make themselves a plate fit for a princess! And have plenty of napkins for sticky hands.
- Hide a drawing of the Pineapple Princess somewhere nearby. Ask the kids to find it for the chance to win a special prize!
- Make copies of the activities in this kit for kids to enjoy. Make sure to provide writing utensils, markers or crayons, children's scissors, and adult supervision.
- Start by reading *Pineapple Princess*!



Read-Aloud Tips

- The Pineapple Princess uses creativity to make herself a crown. Ask the kids what they'd use to make a crown.
- At the end of the story, the Pineapple Princess decides to be a warrior queen. Talk to the kids about why it's okay to change your mind and try different things.

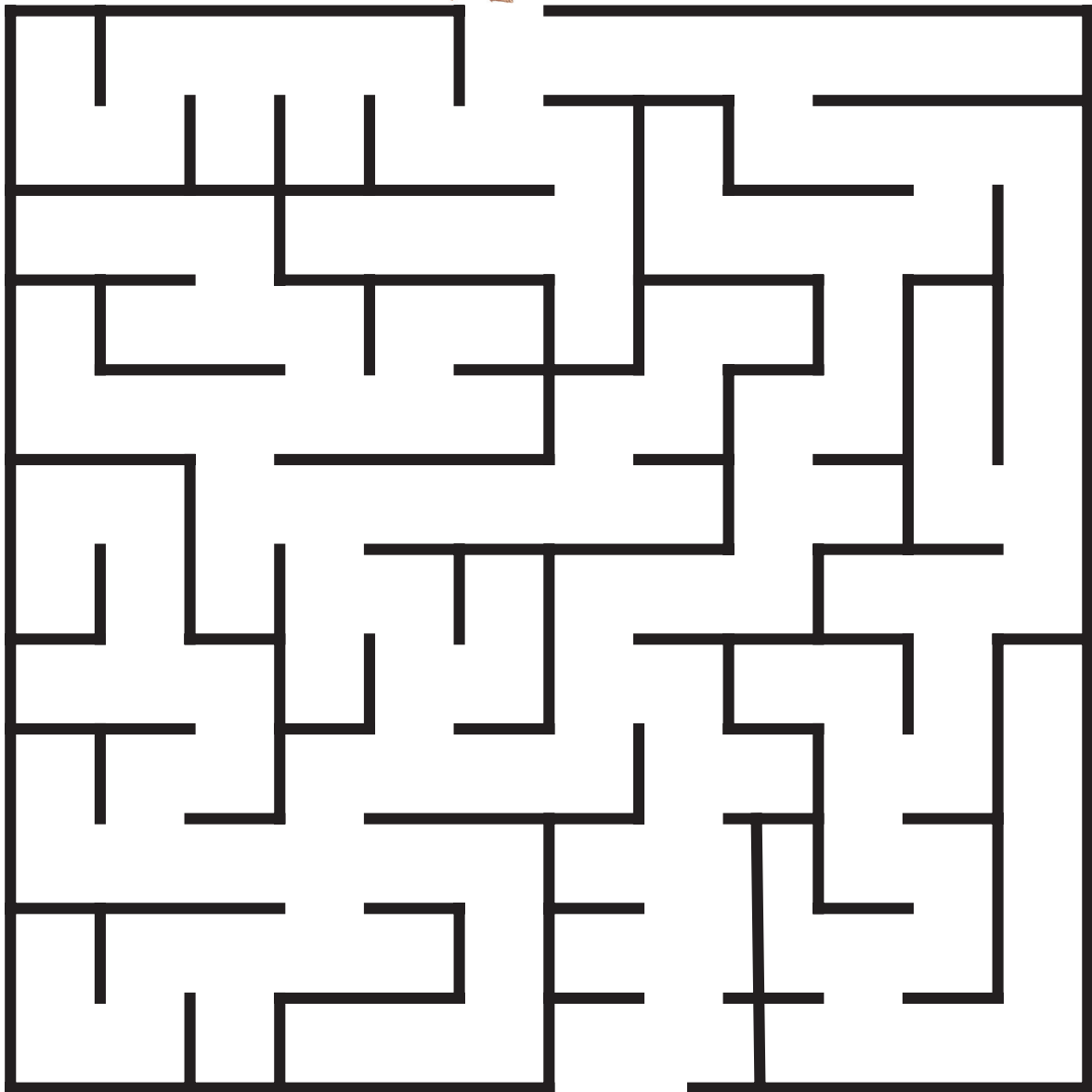

A princess needs a crown! Help the Pineapple Princess find her way through the maze to get to her crown.

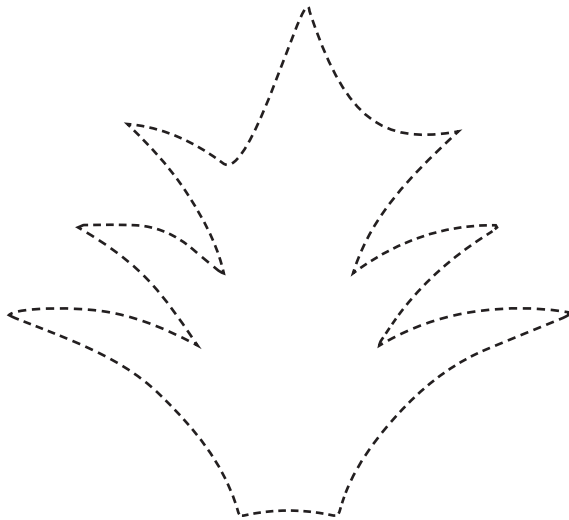
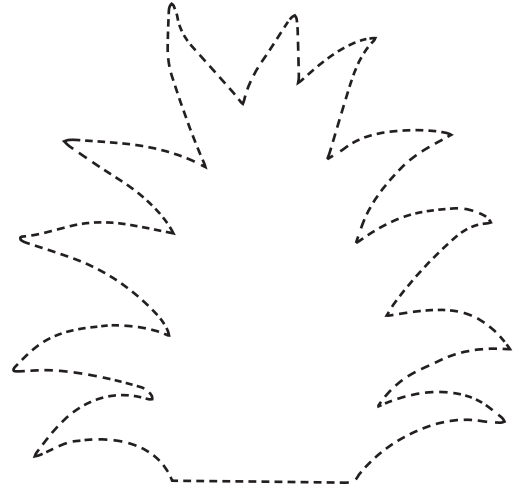
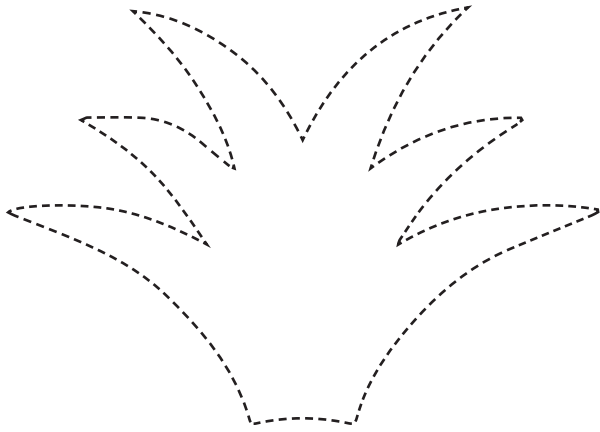

Make Your Own Pineapple Crown

You are clearly meant to be a princess! Ask a grown-up to help you make your own pineapple crown.



Directions

1. Have an adult help cut two long strips of construction paper, fit them to your head, and tape, glue, or staple them together to create the base of your crown. We suggest using yellow construction paper!
2. Cut out the template above and use it to trace pineapple fronds on green construction paper. Ask an adult to help cut them out and attach to your crown.
3. Decorate with pom-poms, gems, feathers, and any other craft supplies that would make your crown special!



Pineapple Princess Matching Game

To play, have a grown-up help cut out all of the cards, mix them up, and lay them facedown.

Taking turns, players flip over two cards. If the cards match, you have made a pair.

Keep those cards. If they don't match, turn them back over and the next player gets a turn.

When all the pairs have been found, the player with the most cards wins!

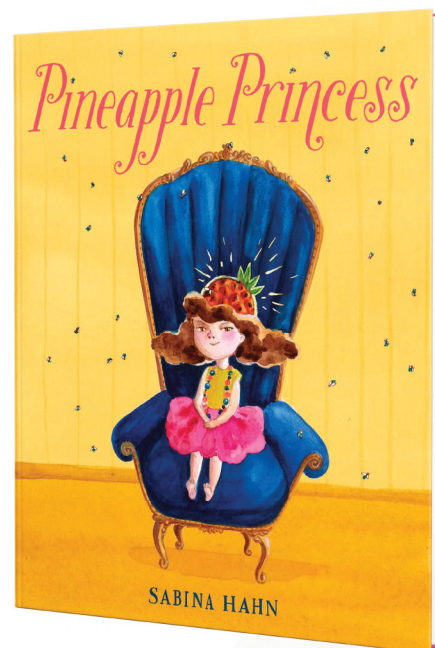
